PC 3PT Club Shootout Rules 2026

Team listed first on schedule or on top of bracket is home team. Home team is responsible for official book. Visitor team is responsible for official clock. IHSAA rules will apply to all games with the following exceptions:

- 1) All games will be played in 4 6-minute quarters. Fouls will follow new IHSAA rules (i.e after 5 fouls/quarter get 2 shots)
- 2) Grades 3-6 will use 28.5 intermediate size basketball. Grades 7-8 will use regulation size ball.
- 3) One minute between quarters except half-time. Half-time shall be no longer than 5 minutes. At least a five-minute pregame warm-up will be given if games are running behind schedule. Games can start up to 30 minutes before their scheduled time.
- 4) Two (2) full timeouts per half, no carry over. One (1) additional time-out per team will be awarded in each overtime period, no carry over. Overtime period will be 3 minutes.
- 5) The clock will be stopped for all whistle stoppages, except clock will continue to run (except for timeouts) in the event of a 20 point or greater lead in the **2nd half of the game. Once a 20 point or greater lead is established the clock will run even if the lead falls below 20 points.**
- 6) Two (2) technical fouls or ejection during a game on any player, coach, or team representative will result in their disqualification for the rest of the tournament.
- 7) Each team is responsible to provide a representative to assist in keeping the scorebook or running the game clock. This must be an adult who will conduct himself or herself in a professional manner.
- 8) Referee's decisions are final.

Roster Rules

Players must participate at present grade level of school. Players can play up in grade level but not down. Team roster **MUST** consist of players that attend the same school or feed into the same high school. Grade and school confirmation should be available upon request by the tournament director.

Pool Play and Tournament Pairings

Each team will play 2 pool games and all teams will advance to a single elimination tournament. Pool tiebreakers are as follows:

- 1) Pool won-loss record.
- 2) Point differential (20 points maximum per game)
- 3) If needed, a coin flip (both coaches & tournament representative present)

Second, Third & Fourth Grade Rules

- 2nd & 3rd grade use 9 ft Goal Height
- 2nd, 3rd & 4th grade may use a 12ft free throw line if they choose.
- 3rd & 4th grade - No full court press until last **2 minutes of game** (if winning team is up by 20, they can not press); **No pressing at 2nd grade level**
- 2nd, 3rd & 4th grade - **No zone defenses**



PC Shootout Gate/Door Fee:

Coaches and team member's gate fee is covered in the registration fee.
Coaches will need to check-in at the Main Entrance.

Parents/Family/Friends can pay at the gym door:

Students 12 and under are Free

Game times will be sent to the Head Coach and posted at the tournament also check Sports Engine app for updates
