





## ALL IN ATHLETICS IS A CERTIFIED ADIDAS GOLD GAUNTLET PROGRAM FOR BOYS & 3SSB PROGRAM FOR GIRLS

ALL IN is 1 of very few Certified adidas grassroots programs in the country for boys AND girls. ALL IN is 1 of 45 boys Gold programs and 1 of 35 girls 3SSB programs across the country that has been invited to play on their respective adidas circuits this season.

The Boys Gold Gauntlet is a three-stop circuit and the Girls 3SSB/Gold Gauntlet is a three-stop circuit for adidas sponsored teams to gain exposure in front of college coaches, media outlets and their peers. Teams face high level national competition, including top 100 players & McDonald's All-Americans. This level of competition prepares players for the challenges and situations they will ultimately face in college, an opportunity that very few programs in the state are able to offer.

ALL IN Elite boys high school teams will play on the adidas Gold Gauntlet. The top team at each age group (15U, 16U, 17U) will compete on the adidas Gold Gauntlet.

ALL IN Elite girls high school teams will play on the adidas 3SSB & adidas Gold Gauntlet. The top team at each age group (15U, 16U, 17U) will compete on the adidas 3SSB circuit.
