OLD BUSINESS

1. March Minutes reviewed and approved

NEW BUSINESS

2. Review and Approve Treasury Report (March & April)
 - Discuss turning credit card processing fees to be charged to registrants vs paid by club. This change will be effective starting Fall 2025 programs
3. BAC Coordination – No new updates at this time.
4. BVU Cup Update – Approximately 220 teams registered. Fields are secured, using the turf fields for U13+ games for tournament – only grass fields are ABC on JCRP East.

Action plan – talk about effects of losing Cliff Fen on programming, what is environmental impact, can we get additional space to east (turfed?), what is plan for parking (it is already very busy on weekends).
