Folkstyle Referees Developmental Director – Jim Littlejohn

- Had a pretty good trip to pre-season nationals.
- A good number of Indiana kids and coaches were out there.
- Good mat time experience for officials.
- Lots of good discussions about things seen at this tournament.
- Asked that someone review the website pull up state tournaments, there are conflicting information.
- Middle School State Duals, the heading says it is on the 9th but in the body of the flyer it says the 8th. Need to be cleaned up a bit.
