- COVID updates: Will put color sticker on sticks to separate LTP into groups to help with social distancing. Leslie will color code the doors

#### **Mites**

- To Date 38 registered; maybe 1 more coming on.
- Practice jerseys given out next practice to start separating to help with social distancing for COVID procedures as well as group skill levels
- Amy will be at front next practice to hand out color jerseys and Board will help direct players to their color door.

- Email sent out to parents reminding to get dressed outside and now come in and go to your color door until time to get on ice
- 2/27 Thunderbirds Team outing, \$18 for food, drink and ticket for player and family Interested in going more than once if an option
- Good on amount of Coaches so far
- Sports Engine is being used to share dates of games, practices and jamborees. Make sure players parents are registered and not “only fan” on the platform so they can see all

- Krista asked for clarification about games and players participation. Leslie said all players will play at Home games. Other games will be by skill level. For example Away team may ask for all our 6 year olds, or best players etc. Or some teams could have 3 skill levels themselves etc

### **COVID Policy/Procedures**

- Main objective is to keep kids on the kids on the ice
- THA says if 1 is positive, whole team quarantines
- GYHA discussed and decided if players/coaches doing the following: masks, separate groups by colors/doors and dress outside then we will determine any possible exposures on a “group” basis
- Legally cannot require masks but will say mandatory
- Scenario and how it will be handled: If 1 Color Group positive they quarantine, if 3-5 color groups, then Team does
- If 2 kids in different groups (same family), for example, 1 in red, 1 in green. Red tests positive then green player will quarantine but not whole team
- If 3 kids in 3 different groups test positive whole team quarantines
- If 4 groups have to quarantine then whole team as well...we have 6 colors
- If Coach tests positive and has followed all procedures, then just hos group quarantines
- For next LTP session, will have parent sign off to COVID restrictions when registering
- Quarantine is 10 days of no GYHA Sponsored Events
