Girls Rec Program Survey Results

Total Responses

▶ 48

Comments/Feedback

- 100% of respondents said their daughter had fun and an opportunity to improve
- 47 of 48 said they would be back to play Rec next year
- Coach explained and demonstrated the rules of the game in ways that the girls were able to understand, and give everyone the opportunity to showcase what they learned during practice."If there are kids that have special needs those parents should be required to be at practices"
- "I felt like they did a great job teaching some of the fundamentals of the game. They were encouraging to the girls but also taught the game without just focusing on fun. My daughter had a blast playing and learned a lot about the game."

Boys Rec Program Survey Results

Total Responses

▶ 109

Comments/Feedback

- 100% of respondents said their daughter had fun and an opportunity to improve
- > 47 of 48 said they would be back to play Rec next year
- "My son thoroughly enjoyed this basketball season! It was just the right amount of games and practices. My son improved his skills and had fun playing!"
- "It was a fun season, the boys improved and again had fun which to us is most important."



Travel Program Survey Results

86 total responses

Successes

- 93% approved of the regular email communication from the club, felt it was timely and the frequency was appropriate
- Only 6% feel the cost is too high 90% feel cost it is appropriate
- 81% felt the number of tourneys played was appropriate

Comments from Surveys

- "I would pay an extra fee for paid coaching. At the 7th/8th grade level, extra focus needs to be on skill development that a paid coach has the knowledge to do. These girls are not going to develop further with parent coaching.."
- "More importance should be placed in development beyond practices. There should be more camps and clinics offered. Also it would be nice if older age groups would help and work with the younger groups. More guidance from the high school program as well"
