Helmet Decal Instructions

Dear Boys Lacrosse player. To create a better team atmosphere, we would like you to add these decals to your helmet per the photos below. The stickers are helmet specific, i.e. so please make sure you have the correct sticker set before peeling them off. If you have problems, please contact Carlos Montesnation at the email below. The first set is covered by team donations. Any additional sets will be \$30.

"DRY" Installation Site Conditions:

- Always install the graphics when the temperature is above 50 degrees F.
- Don't try to install in windy conditions.
- Make sure the surface where you are going to install your decals is absolutely clean and spotless.
- Make sure you have a steady hand when placing the decal.
 - Use a warm soapy solution to clean the exterior of the helmet. After completely drying the helmet, use rubbing alcohol to clean the surface area of the helmet where the decal will be placed. Allow the rubbing alcohol to dry completely before placing the decal.

If you are not comfortable installing vinyl stickers "dry" you can use the "WET" process below.

- 1) Use a warm soapy solution to clean the exterior of the helmet. After completely drying the helmet, use rubbing alcohol to clean the surface area of the helmet where the decal will be placed. Allow the rubbing alcohol to dry completely before the next step.
- 2) Spray installation surface LIGHTLY with soapy water. Peel off decal off backing paper and expose the sticky side of the vinyl. AVOID TOUCHING THE STICKY SIDE WITH YOUR FINGERS.
- 3) Starting at any one side (top, bottom, left, or right), place edge of decal where you want it.
- 4) Slowly lay rest of decal down on installation surface. If needed, gently move decal to exact position where you want it.
- 5) Using "squeegee action", gently smooth out any air or water bubbles on decal, working from the center to outside edges. Do this to avoid trapping air or water bubbles. Allow 1 hour to dry. A hair dryer can be used to accelerate the process.
