  - b. BHS's insurance covered anything on BHS campus or that was paid for by BHS
  - c. The shed at BBC is not covered by the City of Blaine or BHS
  - d. Going forward, Shannon recommends having BHS pay for purchases and the Dugout Club can then make a donation to BHS
  - e. Decision is to inventory items at BBC that are not currently insured (Ted or Bruce will do this) and then get a quote on insurance.
