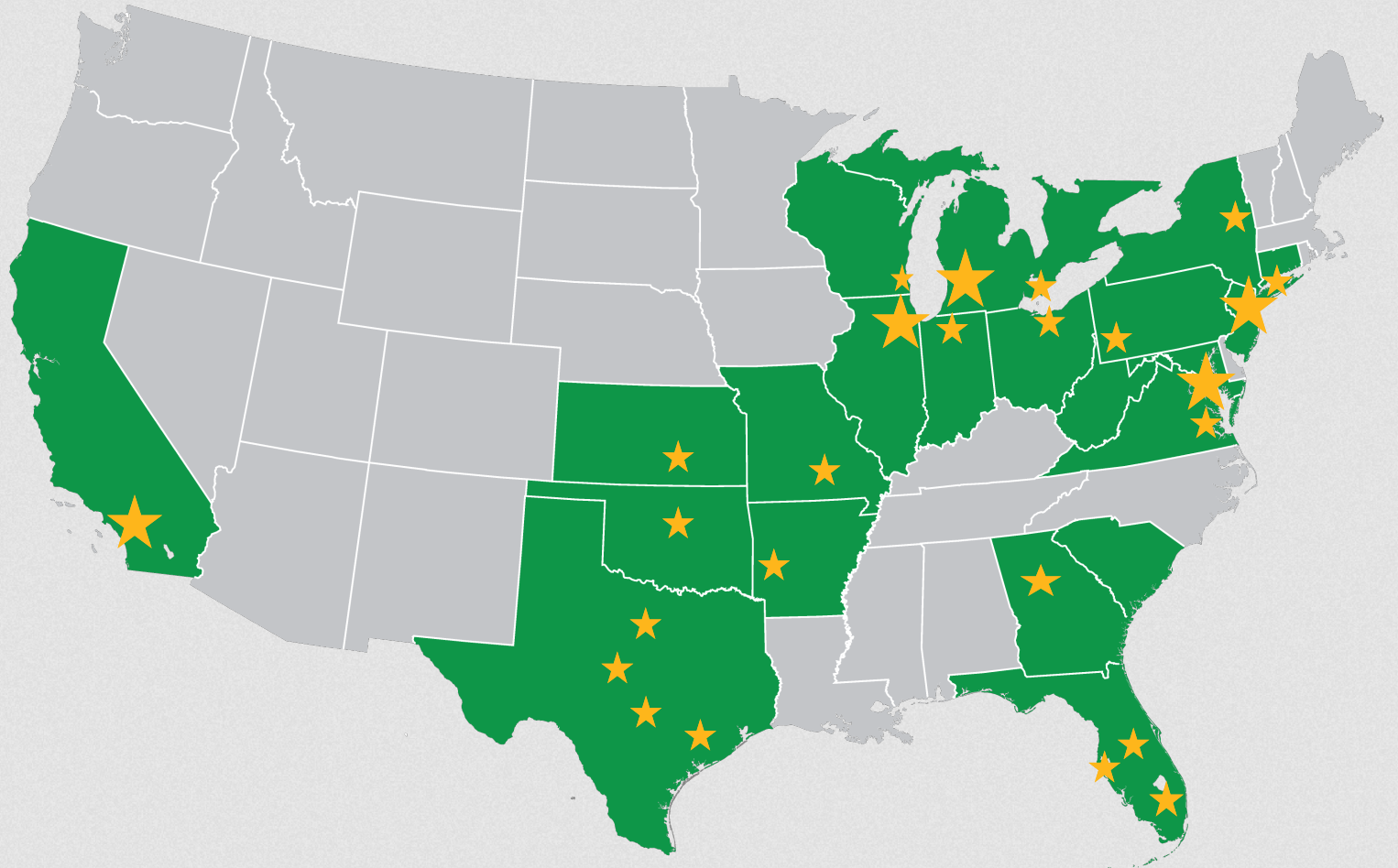

U.S. SOCCER CONNECT (STACK SPORTS)

Implemented in 2019, U.S. Soccer Connect & Stack Sports is the centralized hub for all Super Y League player/coach registrations & game scheduling

- Player and coach registrations roll over year to year
- **Collaborative Scheduling**- communication tool to help with scheduling and reschedules throughout the season
- Ability to set rosters and print before game day
 - Printed rosters w/ player photos eliminate the need for physical ID cards on game days
- Payment for League Fees and Registration Fees are on one portal (association fees)
- Club admins have 24/7 access to portal, eliminates need for requesting reports from League Staff

DIVISIONAL FORMATTING



- Boys and Girls U11-U19
 - Combined age groups for U16/17 & U18/19
 - Age Groups reflect Fall'20 Birth Years
- Flexible 8-10 match schedule
 - Home & Away matches within region
 - Centralized “Neutral Site” matchups to minimize travel & calendar commitments (Division dependent)
- League calendar: May → early August
 - Matches may occur during this time frame but do not have to cover entire timeline
 - Preseason Divisional meetings directed by league allows specific match dates/times are decided by member clubs
- Club Commitments by end of February
 - Earlier commitment gives discounts and additional time for creating teams
