The Lee Community Center is currently facing major improvements and we are asking community members to support us so we can continue to provide opportunities to the surrounding area.

Our Major Projects

Dehumidification System

The dehumidification system is needed to help reduce the moisture in the air inside the building. This will prevent condensation and help to control the air quality throughout the year. It will prevent further structural decay of the Lee Community Center, lower energy cost, eliminate musty odors, enhance air quality, enhance ice quality, and can extend the skating season. *The Stevens County Board of Commissioners has approved exterior roof repairs and door replacement contingent on this system being installed.*

Estimated Cost: \$95,000



Repair/Reskin Hockey Boards

The Lee Community Center is the home for our hockey community in the area. The hockey boards that we currently have came from Mariucci Arena, in Minneapolis when the Lee Community Center was built back in 1994. The hockey boards are in dire need of attention as they have seen significant wear throughout the years. Estimated Cost: \$50,000



Refrigeration System Update

Our building has a refrigeration system that cools the ice arena floor. This system was installed when the arena was built and has been maintained throughout the years by Morris Hockey Association. Just like any system it is becoming out of date and we are seeing growing maintenance costs. Also, environmental laws are requiring systems to use less hazardous refrigerant coolant.

Estimated Cost: \$100,000



What We Provide

The Lee Community Center is used for many activities through the entire year, and it is one of the few places in Morris to hold large events. These events held throughout the year include the following:



The Morris Hockey Association offers varying levels of hockey comprised of 12 teams and nearly 150 players.



The walking track is open to the public year-round.
