



Good evening Bronco Nation! I hope this email finds you and your family doing well and staying safe during this COVID-19 pandemic.

It's hard to believe, but volleyball season is right around the corner so I wanted to share some important upcoming dates and information. The athletes have been cleared to begin practicing this week, however there will be specific requirements as to procedures that will need to be followed due to COVID-19. **Each athlete will need to have their Dragonfly account completed. Dragonfly information is located on the BHS Volleyball website. Also, your athlete will be required to bring in a signed copy of the COVID waiver before they will be allowed to participate on Wednesday. A copy of the form is attached. You also need to be signed up for tryouts which are located on our website homepage.**

Beginning Wednesday, July 8th and Thursday July 9th, open gym will be from 8:30 am to 10:00 am for 9th graders and 10:15 am to 12:15 pm for 10th, 11th and 12th grades.

Open gym the week of Monday July 13th thru Thursday July 16th, will be determined later.

Tryouts will begin the week of Monday July 20th thru Thursday July 23rd, times to be determined later. If you have personal concerns about these dates, please feel free to reach out to Coach Bennum to discuss.

Final cuts will be posted on Thursday, July 23rd.

If your athlete makes the team, there will be a mandatory parent meeting Monday July 27th, time and location to be determined. It is important that you make this meeting as there will be future dates discussed, practices, etc. One item that I would like to make everyone aware of is the collection of dues. In the past we've held tryouts in May, which allowed more time for everyone to have their dues paid. This year, we will need to have payment the evening of the parent meeting, Upcoming year fees are:

All athletes will be responsible for securing a sponsorship as well. If your athlete makes the team, the sponsorship will be due August 3rd.
