

Hello Readington and Tewksbury Families,

We are pleased to announce the opening of registration for the 2020 Spring Readington Tewksbury Jr. Baseball League (RTJBL) to all children ages 4-18. You can access the registration at RTJBL.com or at the link below.

Please help us get the word out to new members, the more players we have the better the experience for all.

Players trying out for middle school teams are able to play rec and middle school at the same time as there is limited conflicts.

- Our registration will close on 1/4/20 for our Rookie 1 through Major 70 divisions.
- Little Sluggers will close 3/7/20
- Babe Ruth 13-15 and 16-18 will close 2/1/20 with the exception of players trying out for any High School Teams, those players will be allowed to register after H.S. cuts have been made.
- Any late registrations are subject to a late fee and will only be accepted if we have not drafted teams and we have enough spots to place that player.

New for the 2020 Season is cross league play with Branchburg for Minors and Major 60/70 divisions. RTJBL teams we will compete against our own teams and Branchburg teams at our fields and at White Oak Park in Branchburg.

Divisions of Play for 2020

Little Sluggers - for players 4 to 6 years old, typically Pre-K and K

Rookie 1 - for players in 1st grade

Rookie 2 - for players in 2nd grade

Minors - for players in 3rd and 4th grade

Majors 60 - for players in 5th and 6th grade

Majors 70 - for players in 6th and 7th grade

Babe Ruth 13-15 - for players not older than 15 years old on May 1st

Babe Ruth 16-18 - for players not older than 18 years old on May 1st

- There is no play-up option for the 2020 RTJBL season on our registration form.
 - 10U and 11U first travel teams will play up one division above their grade level unless parents email to opt out before registration closes.
- 6th and 7th graders have the option to remain in Major 60 or Major 70 as this may be more appropriate for the skill level of the player.
- Clinics for the Little Slugger, Rookie 1 and 2 divisions continue this season.
- New players who did not play RTJBL last year in Rookie 2 through Major 70 divisions will need to attend an evaluation (1/12/2020 in the morning).
- See key dates below, including opening day information.

We have kept our registration fees and work bond the same as last year. The purpose of the work bond is to get more families involved with our league. Attending a meeting counts as 1 hour towards your work bond. More information on the work bond can be found on the registration page for players and coaches.
