- Reports:
 - President
 - Would like to thank everyone for stepping up and helping out this season. We had a very successful season that was full of learning opportunities and lots of growth.
 - CRHL- no big updates
 - Centennial cup was a success. 12u blue did not go. 10u had lots of fun, lost all 3 games. 12u gold made it to the semifinals. 14u brought home the banner, played well, fought hard. 18u great weekend, figured things out and got the banner. Jackson had 3 shut outs.
 - Vice President:
 - Looked at bylaws, they need to be streamlined and matched up to USA hockey guidelines.
 - Throwing around a few fundraiser ideas, possibly before the season gets underway.
 - Treasurer:
 - March 31st is the cut off for team spending. All unspent money will be rolled over to the general fund on that day.

 - Currently we get sports engine through our CRHL and CAHA Fees. Downsides to sports engine: It's not easy to use, website is outdated, not mobile friendly, processing fee is 4%
 - Crossbar: no contract, drag and drop website, mobile friendly, we set up the registration forms, includes options for groups within the app, multiple adults can be assigned to a player, \$69 a month, transaction processing fee is 2.9%, game sheets and calendars tie in,
