



GRANT HUSSEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

ELIGIBILITY

- High school seniors graduating from Eden Prairie High School, with stated plans for post-secondary education.

AWARD CRITERIA

- Past or present participation in Eden Prairie Boys Basketball Association (EPBBA)
 - There may be current or former board members' sons who applied for the scholarship. We don't let that status weigh for or against an applicant. That is neutral, or not a factor.
 - Similarly, no extra consideration is given for those who play High School basketball.
 - We strive to award a mix of players from in-house vs. travel or High School (9,10, JV, Varsity)
- Support for youth basketball programs and/or the community, including volunteer roles
- High standards of personal conduct
- Leadership qualities and experiences
- Academic achievement includes consideration for Advanced Coursework and GPA (as a tiebreaker)

SUBMISSION and SELECTION

- Candidates submit to EPHS Multi-Scholarship Application form by stated deadline
- The Selection Committee will consist of 3-4 EPBBA board members, that may include one executive team member.
 - The Committee is comprised of **EPBBA volunteers who do NOT have a son playing basketball in Grades 9-12 (In-House or HS.)**
 - The decision of the committee will be final.
- Committee to provide winning candidates to Communications Director by end of April. Communications Director will submit names to College and Career Counselor (EPHS) and EPBBA Treasurer.

PAYMENT AND PRESENTATION

- The \$1000 scholarship will be paid directly to each of the winning candidates and presented by Grade 12 Commissioner (or designate) at "Community Scholarship/Awards Evening" at EPHS on Stated Date (usually 3rd week of May.)
