- The Steel clinched a first round bye in the 2020 Clark Cup Playoffs with a 6-5 overtime win against the Dubuque Fighting Saints at Fox Valley Ice Arena on Saturday night ... The 13th victory in a row matches the team's franchise record, set earlier this season ... The Steel have won 37 of their last 30 games ... Chicago is now 30-0-0-0 when leading after two periods ... Both teams put 31 shots on goal through regulation and overtime.
- **Mathieu De St. Phalle** scored the game-winner in overtime, his league-leading 60th point (30G, 30A) of the season.
- **Sam Colangelo** improved his career-best point streak (9G, 5A) to nine games with a marker and an assist. The Northeastern University commit now has 58 points (28G, 30A) on the season.
- **Jimmy Dowd Jr.** tallied his fourth marker of the season.
- **Elis Hede** reached the scoresheet for the third straight outing with a goal.
- **Tyler Carpenter** reached the double-digit mark in tucks with his 10th of the season.
- **John Spetz** registered his 14th goal of the year in the win.
- **Matt Coronato** extended his point streak (7G, 9A) to nine games with three helpers.
- **Brendan Brisson** notched two helpers in the victory.
- **Colton Huard, Josh Doan** and **Uula Ruikka** each registered an assist in the win.
- **Ian Shane** stopped 26 shots and now owns a 16-3-1-0 mark on the year.
- One-year-old dachshund **Barry Sanders** won the Third Annual Steel Wiener Dog Races, defeating 12 other dogs including two-time defending champion **Monty**

Chicago Forward Mathieu De St. Phalle

On Adversity: "Adversity is definitely something we need and we have to learn to embrace. It's not going to be smooth sailing the rest of the year so I think we took it, we ran with it and we stayed composed. I think it set us up well for overtime."

On His Time In Chicago: "Ryan (Hardy), Greg Moore when he was here, Coach Sheahan, they've done so much for me and God knows where I would be without them. I owe a lot to those guys and it's been an awesome time here."

Chicago Forward Sam Colangelo

On The Game: "I think that we got a little loose on the bench. We weren't really focused in as much as we were maybe ten minutes before in the first period and the beginning of the second. I think that should be a pretty good lesson for us to learn. I think learning how to play a close game, it's going to be like that in playoffs and I think it's a good lesson for us to learn now rather than be on the other end of it in playoffs."

On The Team's Depth: "Some guys might not have streaks but everyone's producing. Elis Hede has been on a pretty good streak lately, he's got a couple goals in the last couple games so I think that if we have different guys scoring, it might not be every game, but if we have lots of different guys scoring it's only going to help us down this run."

Chicago Head Coach Brock Sheahan

On Dubuque: "Line rush against is usually one of the strengths of our game. Usually we turn our defense into offense really quick. I thought that they challenged us there tonight, which is good, we'll get better from it."

On The Team's Start: "I thought we had a really good game last night. We could have come out and kind of waited to see how they were going to respond. I thought our first period was unbelievable. I know it was 3-2 after the first but they scored two power-play goals where we just kind of had a couple breakdowns at the end but if you really watch that first period, it was probably the best period of hockey we've played against a real quality opponent."
