Coaches Update:

Requested Purchases:

-Capital Outlay in progress at school.

Orr put in 3 requests: 1) Main court baskets. New floor already approved for next season, will be water-based finish rather than oil-based, and will be complete in June. 2) new record board, with HS Capital Outlay paying \$500, and 2 basketball teams splitting the remaining cost. 3) new white board in locker room, with HS Capital Outlay paying half, and volleyball/basketball splitting rest of cost.

Estimated cost for record board and white board will total \$500. Will come out of 2019/2020 budget if requests are approved. Capital Outlay will meet in April/May to hear requests. Could perhaps take some of this cost out of football concessions.

Other Coach Notes/Announcements:

-Bowling event went well, fun for all girls.

-We are #3 seed for Sections, we host Eagan Feb 27. Play Saturday at 7:00pm home/away vs. Apple Valley. If away game Saturday, bus probably 5:15 p.m

-Discussed ideas to promote student fans at playoff games. Pizza? Pep band playing? Encourage band to stay for entire game. Orr is looking into this. Suggested we use \$200 for pizzas, agreed by all. Perhaps Rosemount Dominos will give us a good discount if they know ahead of time. Ask for 20 pizzas, with limit of \$200. First 20 kids get a free pizza. Orr will call Dominos for delivery at 6:45, to main doors.

Door/ticket attendee will distribute the pizza.

-Summer Schedule is out. HS Weight room and Warehouse – girls have option of either/both, offered on Monday Tuesday, and Thursday. Warehouse Monday 9-930, Tuesday and Thursday 10-1030, with all strength training done at HS. Weight training T/Th 9-945 and Friday 930-1030 with Burdick or Schaefer coaching them. Warehouse is \$50 with max of 25 girls. Weight training is \$45. Sign up is available now, checks made out to Booster Club, registering through Orr.

-Concordia St Paul league: still planning on this, schedule not out yet.

-Cassidy and Mental Toughness Training is going well, girls really engaged. Orr is asking for 8 sessions next season, with first session beginning in summer. Orr is waiting to hear estimated cost from them.

Financial Update:

-Cub Foods brought in \$1080.12 from bagging. First shift makes the most, so maybe we start earlier next year? Recommend more shifts, but less girls per shift? Tonya contacted Rosemount Cub and confirmed Sunday 12/15/19 from 9 am- 5 pm.

-Frisbee Toss went well. \$1269.00 for season.

-Rudy's Red Eye \$318.00

-Current bank balance \$14,630.71

-Current check book balance \$13,283.72. Still \$2600 coming in from Lisa Cline returned check and some outstanding deposits. At this time last year, our balance was \$8,300.

Advertising

-\$4,700 current, missing checks from AAA, Irish Sports Dome, Shamrocks Animal Hospital, Swag Shop, Topps Pizza for \$200 (Orr will follow up with them). Approximately \$700 still coming in.

-2019/2020 Budget meeting will be set for March; need to fill \$3,500 for next season's estimated shortfall.
