# President's Report (Alex Rogosheske)

- Bylaws
  - No new updates or changes to the current Bylaws.
- Ice Schedular(s) Joan Demars, Nate Demars
  - > Joan and Nate are retiring after the 2023-2024 season: limited interest in this paid position.
  - Roseville hired a new ice schedular this season; Alex spoke to the two parents that applied for the Roseville position who didn't get it; initial discussion is they are both interested in hearing more about our position; Alex to schedule time.

### Registration

- > Traveling Teams: Opens July 1, 2023 Closes September 15, 2023
- ➤ Mites/U6/U8/Intro to Hockey: Opens July 1, 2023 Closes October 1, 2023.
  - We are not going to change the date for Mites/U6/U8/Intro to Hockey; anyone who registers after Oct. 1<sup>st</sup> we will provide a code to bypass the registration close date.

# Budget

- Krissy e-mailed out the budget earlier today; new board members had questions; Alex provided an overview; advised that Charitable Gambling is not included in the budget/Krissy does not budget for it; she includes/adds what Charitable Gambling has contributed to the MYHA/what the money was used for; Alex suggested to the Board that Krissy can do a budget review/overview for anyone that is interested.
- > Traveling teams proposed registration fees for the 2023-2024 season for U10/U12/U15, PeeWee and Bantam are all at \$1,995; and Squirt is \$1,895; discussion on why the rate is \$100 lower if the ice is all the same for these teams; Squirt registration was less last year; and that

- was how it was voted on; we agreed that it should all be the same this year; Krissy agreed as well; provided feedback via text to Kelly Taff during the meeting.
  - Discussed the following:
    - O Do we want to continue to reimburse coaches for their required training? The total we reimburse is \$11,000.
    - Do we want to provide a free jersey to first-year Mites/U6/U8 or a reduced jersey fee for Squirts?
  - The attached budget assumes everyone pays 100% for their jerseys and socks and that MYHA will reimburse the coaches for their required training/courses. Discussion was to keep as budgeted/no change.

**MOTION** made by Brent Sorenson to approve the Budget that Krissy Wright e-mailed on June 11, 2023, and to amend the Squirt registration fee; it will increase by \$100 to \$1,995 for 2023-2024 Season. Second by Abe Appert. Unanimous. Motion passes.

# • Ice Contract – Tartan/Polar

➤ 600 hours at Polar and Tartan this season; increase from 450 last year; no formal contract, verbal only; will continue to get hours from them as they are released.

#### • D2 Referees

- Minnesota Hockey Officials Association (MHOA) officials are leaving D2
- D2 is working toward getting them on a new system; we are getting conflicting information from D2, MHOA and past MYHA D2 Rep.; looking to get everyone together/get on the same page.
- Alex, Tom, Abe, and Nick Bradshaw (from MHOA) will all attend the next meeting; need to get on top of this now; have sorted out before the season starts.

# • Fundraising - Rink/MYHA

- ➤ Board discussion continued from last month; variety of ways we can fundraise/raise money for the rink; look at one fundraiser; not several.
- ➤ Tim suggested a Pizza fundraiser; discussion on timing of it; ending it by Thanksgiving; tight window to sell, as teams have only been formed for three weeks; Garth would like to see the Marauders (Mahtomedi Girls) involved in the fundraising; looking to have team/individual goals; prizes for top sellers/teams; discussion on a opting out of fundraising; what would the \$ amt. be per player to opt out; \$200 was suggested; fundraising will need to be a requirement or most will not do it.
- Pizza company MYHA could work with is Shelton Family Pizza, Sagan, MN (just outside of Duluth) Kevin and his wife are willing to lead/research it.
- Alex suggested that at the Town Hall when he provides the update on the rink; we can discuss fundraising; selling Pizza for a purpose.
- Rink fundraising to date; discussion by the time the funds are raised; kids will be gone; how to escalate the timeline.
