The managers are Megan Hesser for 8U, Danyell Mandel for 10U, Billy Knifong for 12U, Liz McCulloch for 14U, Becky Farrell for Girls, and Becky Oswald for High school. Need a safesport certified person in the locker room at all times. Mile High Mites needs to be confirmed. Dale Elder wants compensated for running the program. Dale would like his daughter to be sponsored for the

program as payment. Kevin Parks will do it for free. Dale wants a 10-1 ratio coach to players. Av's will give the association \$1200 for the 6 hours of ice. This could help the 8U program. \$190 per player. 6 one hour ice sessions. Head to toe gear also. The Av's give a practice plan. Only beginner players. Could not have ever played in organized hockey before. Player could get fitted at pure hockey in Denver or order the gear on their website. Dale also feels an hour is to much for beginners and needs to be around 30-45 minutes. Association will be contacting Brice Jacobson to help Kevin with the program.

Schedules are still being moved around. The girls and peewees are still being worked.
