COVID-19 GUIDELINE SUMMARY

10/26/2020

Hockey

- All players should not enter the building earlier than 15 mins before any practice/games. They cannot stay later than 15 mins past their scheduled practice/game.
- All players are **REQUIRED** to come completely dressed with the exception of helmets, skates, gloves. Goalies are also an exception, but should come close to fully dressed as they can.
- A mask must be worn at all times while in the facility. Players can remove their mask when they are on the ice. All coaches are required to wear masks while on the ice per Minnesota Hockey 10/25/20 meeting.
- Social Distancing should be followed in all areas of the Waconia Ice Arena at all times.
- No dryland activities should take place at the ice arena at this time.
- 2 pods of 25 (people) or less at a time with no mixing between groups.

Locker Rooms / Lobby

- We are still rotating between lobby and locker rooms. Locker rooms can only have 7 people in it at max. We use all 4 locker rooms at once.
- Lower viewing/Lobby can have a max of 40 people. 24 in lower viewing, 16 in lobby.
- If there is a game and you are in the lower viewing you will have to communicate with the away team they will be getting ready in the lobby area.

Spectators

- Spectator Guidelines are as follows:
 - 10 years old or younger may have 1 spectator at practice.
 - A maximum of 2 spectators per player are allowed for games. (All Levels)
- Spectators must stay in bleacher area only and follow social distancing rules.

Open Skate

- Open Skate is 25% of arena capacity.
- Rental skates can only be used 1 time per day. Please select sizes appropriately.
- Please practice social distancing while on the ice.
- Wristbands must be worn at all times and will not be put on by staff.
