ASHA HALL OF FAME COACHING CRITERIA

- 1) The minimum years of coaching in ASHA is from 10 to 15 years. This is not limited to head coaching positions. The time limit may be waived if there are extenuating circumstances.
- 2) Time coaching in Alaska High School programs, UAA, or UAF should be considered if they also coached ASHA teams.
- 3) The coach must have made a significant positive impact on our youth and the sport of hockey.
- 4) The nominated coach had significant achievements in 2 or more of the following: league champs, state champs, district champs, national champs, athletic success of individuals coached, leadership roles in national/state/local organizations.
- 5) The selection committee should only consider those in good ethical and moral standing in their community.
- 6) The time after a coach's retirement before they can be considered for nomination is not a factor. Whether the coach is active or inactive, all other requirements must be met.
