Rules of play:

1. All games will be **NO INTENTIONAL CONTACT**
2. All games will be three 16-minute run time periods. Buzzer will sound off at every two minutes for a line change. At the beginning of each shift there will be a faceoff. Clock will be stopped to get set and ready for faceoff. Once the puck is dropped the time will run continuously for the two-minute shift.
3. All games will be half ice.
4. Face offs will occur at the beginning of each shift/period and after a goal is scored.
5. When play is stopped due to a goalie controlling the puck, a whistle will be blown to signal the attacking team to back away and give time for the team with the puck to gain control and resume play. Once the team with the puck has control, the attacking team may attack.
6. Players not in the game must remain on the players bench area. NO sitting on the boards in the player's bench.
7. In all games, players should be ready for their next shift, so the game can run on time.
- 8. Teams should be ready to take the ice ten minutes before scheduled game time.**
9. There will be a three-minute warm up period before each game.
10. Games will only have one official.
11. The **Zero Tolerance Rule** will be followed.
12. Ice resurface time will be on the schedule.
13. If a penalty is called, the player causing the penalty will be asked to leave the ice for their remainder of their shift.
14. Each team must have a coach on the bench.
