- Motion to accept minutes presented by Mark Mundy
- Ben Nicely seconded the motion.
- No discussions
- Motion passed unanimously

- Presented reports that were provided in advance.
- Money is still coming in (memberships, etc.).
- Only real changes since last meeting were Folkstyle State proceeds have come in.
- We had lower numbers in the tournament and less revenue due to limitations.
- Heartland Duals money starting to come in.
- Added Showcase Qualifier and registration and gate fee, but not sure if is finalized.
- Trouble with reporting from Flow Wrestling they are not providing specifics.
- Streaming money did not come in so it should still be coming.
- Starting to pay out expenses for mat officials for national tournaments, etc.
- Revenue under budget for Folkstyle state.
- Fees from IRS have been removed or waived IRS has found our taxes.
- We will need to stay vigilant in regards to our expenses.

Old Business

Pat Culp stated that the Tournament Committee just met and she will let Roby Webster speak on this. We did receive board of health approval to host at Avon.

Freestyle/Greco State

• Pat Culp reported that the qualifier requirement has been lifted for this year, athletes do not have to participate in 2 local tournaments this year to attend Freestyle State.

- We do need to have a conversation about Central Regionals. In the past you had to compete at State to go to Central Regionals and qualifiers for Fargo from Central Regionals do not count against our numbers.
- Brady Eppert asked if we could have a waiver in place that if an athlete competes at UWW
 Juniors they will still be able to participate in Central Regionals.
- He will check to see if placing or winning at UWW Juniors will qualify for Fargo.
- There has been a change in Fargo qualification numbers from Central Regionals.
- Jimmy Tonte, Danny Struck, and Pat Culp will be meeting on this and making a determination.
- Josh Curry has a concern if Central Regionals qualifying numbers are going down, and if we have kids going to UWW's and planned to go to Central Regionals, would this affect athletes in that they may not be qualifying for Fargo.
- Jimmy Tonte said Fargo is allowing 6 per state and you cannot use Central Regionals for qualification for Fargo as far as state numbers.
- Discussions around the numbers for the national team for Fargo.
- Danny Struck will have an answer on the confirmation by tomorrow night's coaches' council.
- Motion presented by Jimmy Tonte to allow a waiver for a kid's that for athletes that wrestle in UWW to wrestle in Central Regionals
- Mark Mundy seconded the motion
- No additional discussions.
- Motion passes unanimously.

Central Regionals

- Pat Culp reported that Mary Friedt has been working hard to set up.
- Any club who would like to work, let her know.
- She needs 2-4 more mats and will have it covered.
- If we know of any clubs that would like to work, let us know.

14U Duals

• Pat Culp reported we will be using 14 mats, 1 for exhibitions.

16U Duals

- Pat Culp reported they had a walk-through at Grand Park
- Will be using 14 mats 1 for exhibitions.
- Working on socials and equipment.
- Anyone planning on being at either even, please let us know.
- We need board members at each event if we could.

Pat Culp reported she has had questions on the flyer and she believes we voted to allow (a couple of years ago) – girls to wrestle pee wee for Freestyle. She said it is listed on the flyer.

Mark Mundy moves to open both Folkstyle and Freestyle for girls' Pee Wee at our state tournaments. Roby Webster seconded the motion.

Thomas Pompei asked about singlets for that size. Pat Culp will check on this with Steve from 3X gear. Motion passes unanimously

Tina Tonte asked for event shirt deadline (for names to be placed on the back) for the flyer.

Roby Webster stated in the flyer, for Cadet trip, it was around \$600 since it was accounting for transportation and hotels. Roby Webster made a motion to change cadet trip to \$300 and leave same as Schoolboy Duals. Jennifer Pierson seconded the motion. Jeff Strueder said we need to look at what we are spending on gear for these trips. Brady asked what the team fee is and determine the actual

cost. Thomas Pompei said it is \$750 per team per style, for both U14/U16. Discussions around cost of gear and camps and we are losing money on the trips.

Motion – passed unanimously

JD will update flyer. Wanted to know if they will run the 16U/14U team camp together. Jimmy Tonte is working on something now. Will try to get it together for tomorrow night at coaches' council. They are looking at combining the camps. Waiting to hear something from Emmanuel lead council (Cody Johnson)

Tournament Committee

- Roby Webster reported we are allowing 3 spectators per wrestler and we are going to allow wrestling siblings in with the wrestler.
- Families with 2 wrestlers in different times, we are allowing their wrestlers to come with the parents.
- We are sticking with 4 club coaches and if over 30 athletes, extra coaches.
- Weigh-ins, athletes will enter door 33 and proceed down hallway.
- Spectator's passes will be figured out.
- Cadets and Juniors will enter door 33, the remaining will enter door 31.
- Masks will be mandatory just like Folkstyle.

- Jeff Strueder asked if they have any accounting from their tournaments, we received \$7000 from USA wrestling for qualifier. We were supposed to get registration and gate. But there was no breakdown on what we had received. He would like to be able to do our own audit of them.
