Outside Competition Sport: Softball

A. Seating

- * Total capacity not to exceed limits appropriate at venue for social distancing. When we reach that point, nobody will be admitted for any reason.
- * We will remove and/or block off bleachers so that they cannot be used by patrons.
- * We will allow patrons to bring in chairs (temporarily suspending our clear bag procedures).
- * We will be proactive at multi-team functions – We will spread games and events out so teams and spectators do not pile up on each during transitions
- * We will have bleachers for our players and opposing players set up outside the dugout. This allows teams to spread out and better social distance within the dugouts and bleachers.
- * We will communicate our plans and procedures with our stakeholders and opposing teams prior to the game.
- * Please purchase your tickets early (you can go on and purchase them for the entire season if you want) via GoFan. We do not want to turn away any family at the gate.

B. Cashless Entry

All tickets through GoFan. Gate workers will have masks, face shields and gloves. They will also be screened prior to starting work that day.

C. Concession Stands

All concession stands will be grab and go.....will encourage cashless options

- * We will encourage cashless options and/or limit the use of coins (price accordingly)
- * Workers must wear mask and gloves
- * Workers must social distance
- * Anyone handling money can't serve food and beverages unless PPE is changed after handling money
- * All previous directions still apply
- * We will move concession areas to tables outside if necessary.

D. Face Masks

Masks are optional, but encouraged.

E. Restrooms

Cleaning will be coordinated with our custodial staff.

F. Safety Awareness

We will have signage explaining all of our new Covid-19 safety procedures.

G. Locker Rooms

Locker rooms will be closed. Home and visiting teams are required to social distance before and after games. We will not be providing ice or water (except in an injury or emergency situation) to opposing teams.

H. Announcer Requirements

Announcer will be isolated from any patrons. Announcer will read GHSA sportsmanship and Covid-19 announcements. Announcer will also give periodic reminders about social distancing and our Covid-19 safety protocols.

Announcer will only read announcements and play music.

I. GHSHA Requirements

All GHSA safety procedures and protocols will be adhered to and enforced.

J. Violations of Rules

Anyone clearly not adhering to the COVID-19 rules will be asked to leave the facility
