



2024 STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Where and when can I weigh-in?
 - Open Divisions have 15 Statewide weigh-in locations Thursday night 6-7pm. [Check List on the Headquarters Page](#)
 - ALL OPEN PARTICIPANTS can go to any of the sites it does not need to be in your region.
 - There will be a last chance weigh-ins offered on Friday. Check the [State Schedule](#) for your divisions assigned weigh-in time.
 - **All Girls State Division Participants MUST Weigh-in onsite Thursday from 4-5pm.**
2. Where and when can I pick up my State gift and Wrestler credential?
 - The Overlook Area (enter through Door 12) will have State gifts and Wrestler credentials.
 - The room will be open an hour before the start of each session and will stay open an hour after the start.
 - Thursdays Wings 6-7pm weigh-in will have Wrestler Credentials available for pick-up.
3. Where and what do I need to do to get Coaches Credentials?
 - Credentials will be in the Overlook Area (Door 12).
 - Regional Directors will have a list with Club Administrator/Coach that is allowed to pick up lanyards. Please bring photo ID. (1 person will get all lanyards for the Team.)
 - All coaches must check in with ID to get their wristband.
 - Coaches' credentials can be picked up at the same time as wrestlers see question above.
4. How many Coaches Passes will my team get?
 - Teams will be allotted passes based on the number of Open Division wrestlers they qualified to State and be allotted an amount they can purchase. A list of allocations will be posted to the State Headquarters page.
 - Unaffiliated wrestlers will be allotted 1 Coaches pass.
5. What is the Admission Price?
 - Adults = \$12.00 per day
 - Students = \$6.00 per day
 - Children 6 years and under = Free
 - Coaches will need to pay admission. Credentials only get you floor access.
 - Wrestlers Credential is their ticket into Wings.
6. Will Wings charge for parking?
 - No
7. Can we bring coolers?
 - No coolers will be allowed inside Wings Event Center
8. Is there a weight allowance for State?
 - All Open Youth Divisions get a 1-pound allowance.
 - High School Divisions do NOT get an allowance.
 - All Girls State Divisions do NOT get an allowance.
9. Can Girls Compete in Open Divisions and All Girls Divisions?
 - Yes – They must qualify with the same requirements for the Open Divisions but can just register for All Girls State.
 - One weigh-in will count for Both Divisions.
10. When will brackets be released?
 - Wednesday March 20th. Check the MYWAY State Championship Headquarters page for links.
11. Can my Wrestler Bring in a bag & food?
 - Wrestlers are allowed to bring in their wrestling bag, they will be searched.
 - Wrestlers can bring in food & drinks for themselves. (1-Gallon Ziplock bag for food & 2 drinks)

NOTES

- For Open Youth Divisions any chart with 8 wrestlers or less will not wrestle until their second day of scheduled competition.
- For Open Youth Divisions Charts with 9 or more wrestlers will compete over 2 days
- High School Divisions will compete until completion on their scheduled day of competition.
- All Girls State Divisions will start Thursday night and run for 2.5 hours. They will return Friday morning to complete their competition.
- When leaving Wings they suggest if its backed up to the left head to the right and go around the block.
