**INDY ELEVEN HEAD COACH MARTIN RENNIE**

***On tonight's result...***

"Very disappointed. Obviously, we were right there at the end. We thought we had the game won. Pretty much last kick of the ball we lose a goal. That was pretty disappointing. Didn't feel like there was four minutes of stoppage time. There shouldn't have been that long and it could've made a difference.

"Going into extra time the game was very even. It could've gone either way. They got a late goal and I feel like we could've too. I don't feel it should've been a penalty. It was two very good teams playing on a difficult field. Both teams played very well. Credit to Louisville, but unlucky for us."

***On the team's run at home this year...***

"We've done really well at home. [Carroll Stadium] is not our home field, unfortunately. It was a great run of 27 games, but it should've been 28."

***On the defensive performance...***

"We've defended well all season. They didn't really have any chances. There was one lapse of concentration where the ball hit the bar, but other than that there wasn't anything dangerous. It was so disappointing to lose the ball with the last kick. From the front we pressed well. Defenders did well all season. It's just disappointing not to see the last few seconds out."

***On moving forward from the loss...***

"The reality is we've done really well this season. The club has come forward a long way. We put ourselves in a great position to host the Eastern Conference Final. Those players have done us proud. They've played a lot of good games for us. We're going to keep improving and make sure we're right up there at the top."

### ***On tonight's match...***

"Disappointed we gave up a late goal. Felt like a lot of stoppage time. I need to be in a better position when that shot (by Hoppenot) comes in. My positioning needs to be better. We're 1-1 so we're going into extra time. We got the stuffing kicked out of us a bit. We had enough energy but one bad step and the penalty, I don't have words for it.

"I'm happy to be able to be in this position and happy to play for a club like Indy Eleven. I have so much love for this club and it pains me to talk to you guys about a loss.
