A Message to Our Try Hockey For Free Registrants (2/20/21 event date)

Thank you for registering for Try Hockey Free at Hagerstown Ice and Sports Complex! We are excited to have your child learn more about hockey, and will have an experienced coaching staff on hand. In order to maintain COVID protocols, we will be dividing this year's event into two sessions. All participants with last names A-M will be on the ice from 9-9:50 AM. All participants with last names N-Z will be on the ice from 10-10:50 AM.

Please arrive 30 minutes prior to your child's ice time in order to get them dressed and ready to go on the ice. We will have information available on all of our programs at a registration table. Make sure to check in as soon as you arrive. Dress warmly! You may need to wait outside until your group is permitted inside the arena.

The following COVID policies will be in effect for the event:

- We have a **limit of 115 people** inside the ice rink. This provides a small amount of room to allow someone to come in to use the restrooms, or for emergencies. Each participant will only be allowed to have **one parent/guardian** with them inside the building. This will be strictly enforced along with the masks.
- Please sign our participation waiver upon checking in at the registration table.
- All patrons will be required to wear a mask at all times. This includes all volunteers, coaches and parents. We will allow the parents of the players to choose if they want their child to wear a mask on the ice.
- We will stage the equipment in the main lobby, where participants will get their gear. Participants will be spread throughout the rest of the facility to put the gear on and off. Locker rooms will not be used for participants to get dressed.
- Of course, we will need to do our best to get the kids moving thru the lines as fast as
 possible to give ample time for everyone to get on the ice. Chad, I would setup this

 they can get to the gear selection and onto the ice.
