The following is a step by step guide to "following" your specific team's calendar.






Once Logged in, verify that all of your kid(s)' teams are on your "Teams" page. You will have a green "MY TEAM" next to the team name. Click on the team name and make sure that the yellow star in the upper right hand is selected so that you are "following" the team.






Then Click the icon in the top right to export to your calendar






Add to your calendar.

For those that have multiple kids or teams, this will be extremely helpful as all events will import as one calendar








Go to "Teams", "House League", and your division (in this example, Farms)












What Gear Should I Get My Player?



Below is a required/recommended list of items at each level of Big Willow.

Big Willow will provide each player with a baseball hat and jersey in the Spring and a jersey for Summer Ball for their team.

REQUIRED:

All players, at all levels, must have their own glove

FARMS/MAJORS-

*Baseball pants or sweatpants required (coaches of each team may make recommendations on color for a uniform look, but it is not required you purchase that color). There is sliding in sand in baseball, so shorts are not appropriate attire. If you do buy pants, we recommend buying two pair as sliding and general baseball play create holes!

*Protective athletic cups are *required* at Juniors, Farms and Majors to avoid injury.

JUNIORS/MITES

* Baseball pants specifically are not required, but sweatpants or other athletic pants ARE. No shorts on the field.



RECOMMENDED:



FARMS/MAJORS-

- * While not required, many kids have their own bat. At these ages, height and strength disparity is greater so while the team will have a few bats to share, it is recommended your child bring their own bat.
- * Cleats are highly recommended as they help with traction in the field and running the bases. A child cannot participate with open-toed shoes of any kind, but can participate with tennis shoes.
- * A personal baseball helmet is also recommended but not required. We have a few helmets for each team that can be shared. Many parents opt to get their child a helmet of their own for sizing and health purposes.
- * If you don't have a water bottle, it is recommended that you get your child one and WRITE THEIR NAME ON IT!

JUNIORS/MITES

- * All of the above for Farms/Majors with the following adjustments
- * A protective cup is recommended but not required at Mites level
- * For Juniors, some people choose to have their own bats. For Mites, we recommend utilizing the bats Big Willow provides as they will outgrow them quickly!
- * For Juniors, cleats are recommended to help with running as well. For Mites it is not necessary but up to the parents if they would like that extra traction.
- * For helmets, same as above, discretion of parent.

Player Attendance

As anyone who's ever coached a kids' baseball team will tell you, last minute notifications create huge challenges in putting together a lineup. At Big Willow, this is especially true for Farms & Majors (in these instances, if your child's absence creates a shortage of players, the coach will have to "call up" from the league below. As much time as possible is critical to find a call-up).

We understand that last minute illness, etc., happen, but as soon as you know your child will not be at a game, **please**, inform your child's coach. This also helps for supervision purposes as the coach will not be looking for your child.



Weather Status

Coaches will send emails ASAP after receiving word of cancellation, but we again **encourage you to follow us on Twitter**. As noted before, the website will also show the posts within five minutes. The Board will make determinations based on local forecasts, field conditions, and intensity of wind/rain.

Coaches

All coaches at Big Willow are **volunteers** and almost always a parent of one of the players. Please remember that they will do their best and need the support of the parents on the team. If for some reason you are having issues/concerns that you cannot address directly with the coach, please contact president@bigwillowbaseball.com



Family Game Attendance

We are a community that prides itself on an uplifting, positive, supportive atmosphere. We have to remember that this is kids' baseball and the #1 goal is to have fun! We kindly ask that you support the teams and not shout at the umpires (who also are trained, but not full-time professionals!). If you have a concern with anything happening during the game or with the umpiring, please speak with your team's coach after the game.



"Build Each Other Up"

Dear Parents/Coaches,

At Big Willow, not only do we strive to provide great baseball programming, we work to foster a positive environment for all players. For this reason, we will be using a league-wide mantra throughout practices and games. Please have a talk with your players/kids that their job whether in the dugout or on the field is to build each other up. This is applicable both on and off the field.

Safe Sports Act Compliance

Our league has always been about creating a safe environment for our players and their families. The recently passed legislation is being followed and all Board Members have taken the necessary training. Coaches will also be educated and informed on what it means to provide a safe environment on the team.

One key note for all families is that COACHES **MAY NOT** DRIVE CHILDREN, OTHER THAN THEIR OWN, HOME FROM PRACTICE/GAME/OR TOURNAMENT. Please do not ask and please make arrangements for your children to and from the field.

If your child's coach is a family friend, etc., you **MUST** email <u>president@bigwillowbaseball.com</u> with the coach on the copy informing them of your consent to allow them a ride home **PRIOR** to practice/game/tournament, otherwise the Coach **shall not** provide a ride home.

We have not had issues before this new rule, rather it is a requirement now by law that we must follow.



Concessions

For those without exemptions (i.e. Head Coaches) all families are required to assist a few times in the concession stand. Note that not only is a great service to have during games to get food and drink, it's also a way we are able to keep the costs of field maintenance and registration down. Please - eat, drink, and support Big Willow Baseball!












CLICK ON "CONCESSIONS VOLUNTEER SHIFTS"
