

## ROSEMOUNT AREA HOCKEY ASSOCIATION PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT | SEASON: 2023 - 2024

Rosemount Area Hockey Association has implemented the following Parent Code of Conduct, which serves as an important message about the proper role of a parent in supporting their child in youth hockey. Any parent exhibiting improper conduct at any game or practice will be asked to leave the arena and will not be allowed to attend the following game. Repeat occurrences may result in a multiple game suspension or lose the privilege of attending all future RAHA events.

The essential elements of character-building and ethics in sports are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship which include:

Parents play a vital role in the development of athletes. It is the duty of all parents to exemplify the highest ideals of sportsmanship, ethical conduct and fair play. All parents are expected to abide by the guideline for behavior described in the following Code of Conduct:

- 1. I will embrace the highest ideals of sportsmanship, ethical conduct and fair play.
- 2. I will support coaches and officials working with my child in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- 3. I (and my guests) will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and respect that all practices are ran by the coaching staff.
- 4. I will be a "team fan" not a "my child fan".
- 5. I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials, and spectators with respect.
- 6. I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent (i.e. booing, profane language).
- 7. I will be modest in victory and gracious in defeat.
