The CCYBSA is continuing to plan for and to have a 2021 season. However, please be aware of any COVID restrictions (if any) that may impact a 2021 season and the association needing to alter plans. The CCYBSA Board will continue to monitor and communicate as early as possible any alterations or changes to the 2021 season.

NEW ASSOCIATION REQUIREMENT

Starting in 2021, the CCYBSA will now require all players, in all programs starting in an 8U program and up (7/8 Yr Old Baseball Program & 8U Softball Program) to purchase and have their own Batting Helmet to play in. The safety and health of all CCYBSA players and family members is important to our association. Looking to live in a COVID or post-COVID world, minimizing and/or eliminating the use of sharing equipment will help in reducing any kind of transmission spread. The CCYBSA will be offering an online store in 2021 where batting helmets may be ordered and purchased. All batting helmets purchased through the CCYBSA online store, will include a “Carver” logo on the helmet. For any players/families that choose to purchase a helmet through another source, please reach out to a CCYBSA rep and/or your coach and a decal logo for your helmet will be provided, free of charge.

2021 Programs

Carver is pleased to offer the following programs:

T-Ball – 4/5 Year Old Division - \$65.00

- This is a Co-Ed (Boy/Girl) Division
- Played only in Carver, no traveling.
- Player T-shirt Uniform included.
- 1-hour time slot for play, 2x a week; Coaches structure the time, typically first 30 mins is teach/coach fundamentals, second 30 mins is game/scrimmage.
- Play Occurs on Monday and Wednesday Nights: May 24 and May 26; June 2, 7, 9, 14, 16, 21, 23, 28, & 30. June 28th is the end of the season trophy presentation. Final game and backup date for trophy presentation is June 30th.

T-Ball/Intro to Coach Pitch – 6 Year Old Division - \$85.00

- New Program for 2021!
- This is a Co-Ed (Boy/Girl) Division
- Played only in Carver, no traveling.
- Player Uniform includes: Jersey, Pants, Hat, and Socks.
- 1-hour time slot for play, 2x a week
- Season emphasized on T-Ball Play for first 2 weeks and Coach Pitch Play for last 4 weeks
- Play occurs on Tuesday and Thursday Nights: May 25 and May 27; June 1, 3, 8, 10, 15, 17, 22, 24, 29 & July 1. June 29th is the end of the season trophy presentation. Final game and backup date for trophy presentation is July 1st.

Baseball: Community Ball

Community ball includes practice and/or a game starting Mid-May (or when weather permits). Balance of league games start after school is out with typically 2 games per week. Distance to league games is considered local.

Coach Pitch Baseball – 7/8 Year Old Division - \$135.00

- Played in Carver against Carver Teams with potential play against Victoria's Program
- Player Uniform includes: Jersey, Pants, Belt, Hat, and Socks.
- 1-hour time slot for play, 2x a week
- Tentative play occurs on Monday and Wednesday Nights: May 17, 19, 24, & 26; June 2, 7, 9, 14, 16, 21, 23, 28, & 30; July 7, 12, & 14. July 12th is the end of the season trophy presentation. Final game and backup date for trophy presentation is July 14th.

Kid Pitch Baseball – 9/10 Year Old Division - \$150.00

- Played in Carver against Carver Teams and in Chaska against Chaska's Program/Teams
- Player Uniform includes: Jersey, Pants, Belt, Hat, and Socks.
- 1-hour to hour fifteen minute time slot for play, 2x a week
- Tentative play occurs on Tuesday and Thursday Nights: May 18, 20, 25, & 27; June 1, 3, 8, 10, 15, 17, 22, 24, & 29; July 1, 6, 8, 13, & 15. July 17-18 End of Year Tournament against Chaska.

SW Community League

11 Year Old Division - \$185.00

12/13 Year Old Division - \$190.00

14/15 Year Old Division - \$190.00

16-18 Year Old Division - \$190.00

- League Play is against teams from Belle Plain, Chanhassen, Chaska, Eden Prairie, Edina, Shakopee and others
- Player Uniform includes: Jersey, Pants, Belt, Hat, and Socks
- Start Date TBD; Typically the 3rd week of May
- Dates of Play may vary based on fields in each Community
- Year-end tournament around July 16th-18th.

Softball: Community Ball

Community ball includes practice and/or a game a week starting sometime in May (or when weather permits). Balance of league games start after school is out with typically 2 games per week. Distance to league games is considered local.

Coach Pitch Softball – 8U Division (Formerly “K-2” Program) - \$125.00

- Played in Carver, Chanhassen and Chaska
- Player Uniform includes: Jersey, Pants, and Socks.
- *Requirement: Defense Fielder's Mask must be purchased and available to be worn for play*
- 1-hour time slot for play, 2x a week
- Tentative play occurs on Monday and Wednesday Nights: May 17, 19, 24, & 26; June 2, 7, 9, 14, 16, 21, 23, 28 & 30. July 7, 12, & 14. July 12th is the end of the season trophy presentation. Final game and backup date for trophy presentation is July 14th.

Machine Pitch Softball – 10U Division - \$135.00

- Played in Waconia League: Teams against Waconia, St. Boni, Watertown, Norwood Young America, Cologne, Belle Plaine, and others (*League Play subject to change*)
- Player Uniform includes: Jersey, Pants, and Socks.
- *Requirement: Defense Fielder's Mask must be purchased and available to be worn for play*
- Approx 1-hour to hour fifteen minute time slot for play, 2x a week
- Tentative play occurs on Monday and Wednesday Nights: May 17, 19, 24, & 26; June 2, 7, 9, 14, 16, 21, 23, 28 & 30. July 7. Potential of a “Second Season Play” for 10U Division being a Kid Pitch Season would be from mid-July for approx. a 3 week season.

Kid Pitch Softball – 12U Division - \$150.00

- Played in Waconia League: Teams against Waconia, St. Boni, Watertown, Norwood Young America, Cologne, Belle Plaine, and others (*League Play subject to change*)
- Player Uniform includes: Jersey, Pants, and Socks.
- *Requirement: Defense Fielder's Mask must be purchased and available to be worn for play*
- Approx 1-hour to hour fifteen minute time slot for play, 2x a week
- Tentative play occurs on Monday and Wednesday Nights: May 17, 19, 24, & 26; June 2, 7, 9, 14, 16, 21, 23, 28 & 30. July 7. Tentative Year End Tournament Play: TBD (Mid-July)

Travel Ball Options

Travel ball includes a higher fee, more practices, the level of games will be more competitive, the distance to travel to games will be greater, a couple of weekend tournaments and a possible State tournament to play in if the team qualifies. A traveling program has been offered in Carver in the past, however a traveling team may not be guaranteed due to a limited amount of registered players. A traveling program takes dedicated parents and coaches that are willing to help where help is needed in abiding by all league rules and requirements. A traveling team(s), whether for Baseball or Softball in Carver requires that there is enough players to field a team while also having at least 2 coaches that can commit to all the duties of a travel program.

Travel Baseball – Metro Baseball League

10U, 11U, 12U, 13U, 14U, & 15U Division - \$435.00

- Age division to play in is based on age of player as of May 1st
- League Play is against teams from all over the metro area
- Player Uniform includes: 2 Jerseys, Pants, Belt, Hat, and Socks
- Start Date TBD; Typically the Middle of April (Weather Pending)
- Dates of Play may vary based on field availability in each Community
- League games could take place on weekdays; Up to 3 Weekend Tournaments can be played
- Year-end additional tournament play for State Qualifiers can be played; Mid-July timeframe.

Travel Softball – Metro & Big West League

8U – Metro League - \$275.00

- Age division to play in is based on age of player; may play up a division
- League Play is against teams from all over the metro area
- Player Uniform includes: 2 Jerseys, Pants, and Socks
- *Requirement: Defense Fielder's Mask must be purchased and available to be worn for play*
- Start Date TBD; Typically middle to late April (Weather Pending)
- Dates of Play may vary based on field availability in each Community
- League games could take place on weekdays; Weekend Tournament play also occurs
- Year-end additional tournament play for State Qualifiers can be played; Mid-July timeframe.

Registration Requirements

- All communities are welcome to register for Carver Association programs.
- All teams must have a coach in order to become a viable team. Please consider being a coach!
- All families with their registration fee will receive a \$25 MVP fundraiser card. Additional MVP cards will be available to purchase...would make great gift to family members.

Volunteer Requirements – *New For 2021!*

- New “Dibs” Volunteer system through ccybsa.com website will be utilized to sign up for volunteer opportunities and to track progress
- All Families are required to Volunteer
- A total of 6 hours is required to Volunteer
- Volunteer Fee per Family is \$150
 - ***Important*** - In 2021 the Volunteer Fee will be placed on a payment plan for all families. What does this mean?
 - At the time of registration, all families will be charged \$1 of their \$150 Volunteer Fee
 - The remaining \$149 of the Volunteer Fee will be charged to your credit card on August 1st
 - If your 6 volunteer hours are fulfilled by July 31st or earlier, the pending \$149 charge will be canceled, and your credit card will *not* be charged
 - If you do not volunteer at all or fulfill ***all*** of your 6 volunteer hours by July 31st, you will forfeit your remaining \$149 of your Volunteer Fee and your credit card will be charged on August 1st.
- A Volunteer “Buyout” package will be offered and charged at the time of registration. The Buyout amount is \$250 and no volunteer hours are needed to be worked.
- T-Ball Only registered families are not required to volunteer nor pay the Volunteer Fee

Reimbursement and Coaching Information

- All coaching staff, up to 3 (not including T-ball), get Volunteer Fees reimbursed (\$150)
- **Coaching Staff:** attend meetings as needed, pick up equipment, send weekly communications to team about practice/game schedule, plan in advance drills for practices (CCYBSA staff will help with this), arrive ahead of team to set up and be prepared for practice/games, communicate to CCYBSA Board any needs or issues and return equipment bags
- ***All coaches and any individuals who have contact with children will be required to complete a coaches registration which a Background Check, Safe Sport training and Concussion training will need to be completed before you step onto a field.***
