## **Team Checkbooks**

- Our association banks with Royal Credit Union (formerly Lake Area Bank).
- One checkbook per team is with Ashley/Eric/Jess
- Manager and head coach must go to WBL bank branch to sign documentation prior to writing checks.
- Each team needs TWO authorized signers (preferably Coach and Manager)
- Signers may not write checks to themselves or family members.
- Bank statements are available at Royal Credit Union.
- If you run out of checks, email Eric treasurer@wblhockey.com.
- DO NOT ORDER ADDITIONAL CHECKS FOR YOUR ACCOUNT
- Every account has a starting balance of \$5 and must reconcile at
   The end of the season with \$5

## **Registration and Base Fees**

Registration and Base fees collected through SportsEngine will be used by the Association to pay for the following expenses:

# **Coach Registration**

#### MANDATORY Steps to Become a USA Hockey Coach FOR WBLAHA:

USA Hockey Requirements (Must be completed before participating in any team activities)

- Register as a member of USA Hockey. (Cost is \$46 plus any affiliate fees if applicable).
- Complete the WBLAHA Online Registration.
- Complete the background screening.
- Complete the USA Hockey Safe Sport Training. (Required every year and cannot be added to a roster until completed).
- Complete the Foundations of Player Development Pre-requisite. (Coaches will need to complete the Foundations of Player Development module before purchasing their age-specific module. Once a coach completes the Foundations of Player Development module there will be a 15-minute window before they can purchase and complete their age-specific module).
- Complete the online age-specific module(s) for the age level of play you are coaching. (Cost is \$10 per module and only needs to be completed once per age level. Must be completed PRIOR to participating in any team activities and cannot be added to a roster until completed)
- Complete CEP Class: Coaching Education Program (CEP) Certification Clinic Requirements MUST be completed by Dec. 31st each season OR YOU WILL BE REDLINED and not allowed on the ice.

\*\*IF THESE ARE NOT COMPLETE, THEY CANNOT BE ON THE ICE OR BENCH

# **Concussion Policy**

- Each coach will provide a <u>Coach Concussion Certificate</u> each year.
- If a player receives a concussion, the coach is required to fill out the concussion form within 48 hours of being notified of the concussion.
- The team manager will give a copy of the report to the parents/guardian and the association president.
- Penalty for not completing the form and allowing the player to continue to play:
  - 1st offense, coach is suspended for the next 2 games.
  - o 2<sup>nd</sup> offense, coach will receive a 2 week suspension.
  - o 3<sup>rd</sup> offense, coach is suspended for full calendar year.
- MN Hockey Return to Play form needs to be completed by 3rd party health professional\*\*



## Rosters

- Rosters will be submitted electronically
- Need at least 5 days turnaround for roster approval
- NO ONE should be on the ice or bench unless they are on your team's roster! (Parents, coaches, players, kids, etc.)
- After roster is approved, any new player or coach is not allowed on ice/bench until new roster is approved
- Scrimmages/games/tournaments with team from an outside association - must have official roster
- Student Coaches Must be registered with USA Hockey and be added to roster. Also, must be 1 age level higher than coaching

# **D2 Playoffs**

- Every Squirt, U10, Pee Wee, U12, Bantam, Jr Gold team will be responsible for providing volunteers
- Association is fined if volunteers do not show up for their shifts
- Non-state eligible teams (B2, C) only top 8 teams in district go to District 2 playoffs

- Register as a Volunteer with USA Hockey
- Register as Locker Room Monitor on WBLAHA website
- Complete Background Screening at MN Hockey (email the receipt to the Treasurers)
- Complete Safesport Training



# Player/Parent Cell Phone Policy

The use of cell phones, iPods and tablets are strictly prohibited in any locker room.

- 1st Offense: One game suspension
- 2nd Offense: Two weeks suspension
- 3rd Offense: Removed from the team with no refund on team/registration fees



## **Tournament & Volunteer Directors**

- Divisions hosted: 10U A&B, 12U A, PeeWee AA, Bantam A, Bantam AA and Jr. Gold B
- WBL Teams are required to pay half of the registration fee payment can be submitted any time prior to the tourney
- Each team that hosts is required to have 1 or 2 point people available throughout the tournament. Let Emily & Paul know your contacts as early as possible but no later than 2 weeks prior to the start date of tournament.
- Teams are given an opportunity to work score table shifts at their tourney as a fundraiser. Workers are paid for each shift through monies collected by the association at registration.
- Unfilled shifts are offered to other teams or individuals but are ultimately the responsibility of the hosting team.
- Bantam aged and above can fill shifts. But must know how to fulfill duties before first shift.
- GameSheets is used for the book/scoring the games.

## **Dibs**

- \$45 Dibs fee paid at registration
- Team opportunity to fundraise by working tournaments
  - Penalty Box, Book, Clock, Announce & Welcome Desk
  - Amount is TBD (\$1000-\$1500)
  - Coverage of tournament duties will be in bulk.
- Shifts NOT covered by fundraising, will be the responsibility of the WBL team playing in the tournament

## **Association Sponsors vs. Team Sponsors**
