

DEAL SYNAGOGUE SOFTBALL LEAGUE

BLACK DAY AT BED ROCK

AS HEAT WALLOPS CHUBBY TWICE 15-10 and 13-1, BEDROCKERS FINALLY RUN OUT OF LUCK. IN THE VERY FIRST INNING HEAT JUMPS ALL OVER CHUBBY FOR 7 RUNS A COUPLE OF ERRORS HELPED THEM ALONG BUT, HEAT TOOK ADVANTAGE OF THE MISCUES. RED DOUBLES IN 3 RUNS AND EDDIE BEDA AND ELI GINDI ADD TO THE ATTACK. AFTER A SHREM 2 RUN DOUBLE LABO WALLOPS A 3-RUN HOMERUN AND THE LEAD SWELLS TO 13-3. THEN THE BEDROCKERS STAGED A DRAMATIC COMEBACK BEHIND IKE FRANCO'S 2 STRIKE 2 RUN TRIPLE, ELLIOT BRAHA'S SINGLE AND SAMMY TAWILS TRIPLE AND BEFORE YOU COULD SAY CHUB-CHUB THE BEDROCKERS HAD CLOSED THE GAP TO 13-10. HOWEVER RED BORE DOWN AND IRWIN GINDI'S TWO-RUN SINGLE CLOSED OUT THE SCORING TO 15-10.

IN THE 2nd GAME THE BEDROCKERS WERE NO MATCH FOR THE JUBILANT HEAT TEAM. JACKY HADDAD'S SINGLE AND IRWIN GINDI'S TRIPLE OPENED A 4-0 LEAD. ELI HADDAD AND ELI GINDI HITS STRETCHED IT TO 6-0 AND LABO'S MONSTER 2-RUN HOMERUN CLOSED OUT THE ROUT 13-1. THE BEDROCKERS BLACK DAY WAS OVER AND NOW FIRST PLACE WILL BE UP FOR GRABS NEXT WEEK. ELLIOT AND COMPANY WILL HAVE A CHANCE TO GET REVENGE NEXT WEEK AS THEY PLAY RED AND COMPANY. NEXT WEEK AGAIN.

HAT TRICK SWEEPS PALS 12-7 and 13-12. THE CAPTAIN WAS WORKING BUT SEEMED TO BE THERE IN SPIRIT. AFTER VIEWING THE HITTING POWER OF THE HAT TRICK TEAM WE WOULD HAVE TO ADD DAVID ZILBERMAN TO THE 3 OTHERS WE MENTIONED BEFORE. WITHOUT EXCEPTION ZILBERMAN, BRAHA, HADDAD, AND MISSRY ARE THE 4 MOST DANGEROUS HITTERS IN A ROW IN ANY LINEUP. OTHER TEAMS HAVE TWO AND SOME HAVE THREE MONSTERS IN

A ROW, BUT, NOBODY HAS 4 QUALITY HITTERS IN A ROW AS GOOD AS THESE.

IN THE FIRST GAME ISAAC BETESH GOT THE PALS IN FRONT WITH A TRIPLE. THEN HAT TRICK BEGAN TO ROLL AND BEFORE YOU KNOW IT THEY HAD A 7-1 LEAD AS EVERYBODY CHIPPED IN. BUT THE PALS HAVE SOME REAL HITTERS THEMSELVES. FREDDIE ZALTA AS GOOD AS ANY OF THE HAT TRICK'S BIG FOUR SMACKED A 2-RUN HOMER. MARSHALL THEN CLEARED THE FENCE TO THE RIGHT OF HOUSE TO MAKE IT 7-5. BUT HAT TRICK CAME RIGHT BACK WITH A ZILBERMAN 3 RUN BLAST TO WIN 12-7. HAT TRICK LOOKED GOOD IN THIS GAME AS THEY DID WHAT THEY HAD TO DO TO WIN.

IN THE SECOND GAME THE PALS BROKE OUT ON TOP BEHIND ANOTHER ALLIE MARSHALL HOMERUN AND A ALLIE MARSHALL BASES LOADED SINGLE TURNED INTO 4 RUNS ON A BAD THROW. SCORE AFTER 4 INNINGS PALS 7 HAT TRICK 3. BUT HAT TRICKS HITTING BROUGHT THEM RIGHT BACK. ANOTHER ZILBERMAN HOMERUN, A BRAHA 2 RUN SINGLE, A MISSRY 2 RUN HOMERUN, AND A HADDAD 2 RUN SINGLE (THOSE 4 AGAIN) AND BEFORE YOU COULD SAY HAT TRICK THE SCORE WAS 11-9 HAT TRICK. THEY MADE IT 13-9 GOING TO THE BOTTOM OF THE 7th AND THEN THE PALS UNLEASHED THEIR POWER AND IF NOT FOR A GREAT CATCH BY ALAN HADAD THEY WOULD HAVE TIED THE SCORE. DOWN BY THREE AND WITH TWO ON BASE FREDDIE ZALTA BELTED ONE TO DEEP RIGHT THAT HAD HOMERUN WRITTEN ALL OVER IT. ALAN WENT BACK AND MADE A ONE-HANDED CATCH. THEN MARSHALL CAME UP AND SMACKED A 3-RUN HOMER THAT BROUGHT THE PALS 1 RUN SHORT. FINAL SCORE 13-12. PALS SHOWED A LOT INCOMING FROM BEHIND. THEY PLAY RASCALS NEXT WEEK AND WITH ABIE OUT WILL HAVE THE EDGE. HAT TRICK IN A BIG DOUBLEHEADER WITH BIG TIME NEXT WEEK. ALLIE MARSHALL WITH THREE

HOMERUN'S AND A BASES CLEARING SINGLE BATTED IN 11 RUNS ON THE DAY IN A LOSING CAUSE. HOMERUNS IN THE DOUBLEHEADER MARSHALL 3, ZILBERMAN 2, MISSRY 1, ZALTA 1 (PLUS 1 CALLED FOUL). DENNY DAYAN MADE THE FIELDING PLAY OF THE DAY AT SECOND BASE. ZINN DOING AN OUTSTANDING JOB AT 2nd BASE FOR HAT TRICK STOPPING EVERYTHING IN SIGHT. MARTY SAYS STEVIE PULLED A FAST ONE GETTING HIM AS A 14th ROUND REPLACEMENT WHEN HE SHOULD HAVE BE A 7th ROUND. MARTY MIZ HAD AN OUTSTANDING DAY AT THE PLATE.

THERE IS A NEW RULE IN EFFECT SINCE YOGI'S WIFE HAS BEEN ADDED TO THE HAT TRICK CHEERING SQUAD. THERE WILL BE A LIMIT OF ONLY 2 KASSIN (OR RELATED TO KASSIN) CHEERLEADERS PER GAME. THAT MEANS ADRIENNE STAYS HOME FROM NOW ON.

BIG TIME ROLLS ON

THIS TEAM GETS BETTER AND BETTER EACH WEEK AND NOW HAS 7 WINS IN A ROW. DEFINITELY THE TEAM TO BEAT RIGHT NOW. TRUE THEY GOT A BIG BREAK WHEN ABIE COHEN UNFORTUNATELY BROKE HIS ANKLE BUT, THEY WERE WINNING HANDILY WHEN IT HAPPENED. IN THE 2nd GAME WITHOUT ABIE THE RASCALS WERE NO MATCH FOR BIG TIME AS THEY WENT DOWN 9-2. ALBERT LEVY PITCHED FOR THE RASCALS BUT EVEN THOUGH HE DECKED A FEW BATTERS HE COULDN'T HOLD THEM DOWN. BIG TIME NOW 7 AND 3 AND BREATHING HEAVILY ON THE BEDROCKERS WHO LOST 2. MAY 29th IS A BIG DATE FOR THESE 2 CLUBS. IT WILL PROBABLY BE A BATTLE FOR 1st PLACE. (THATS

BUT EZRA REACHED BACK AND GOT THREE IN A ROW ON POP-UPS TO KEEP THE SCORE TIED. IKEY YEDID BELTED A 2-RUN HOMER IN THE NEXT INNING TO PUT PEACHES IN FRONT 5-3. THEN CAME THE TURNING POINT OF THE GAME. WITH 2 ON AND NONE OUT GRAND SLAM WAS THREATENING TO OVERTAKE THE LEAD. EDDIE ANZAROUTH THEN LINED WHAT LOOKED LIKE A SURE HIT TO RIGHT ONLY TO SEE DAVID SHAZMULA MAKE A GREAT CATCH AND TURN IT INTO A RALLY KILLING DOUBLE PLAY. IKE DWECK AND JACKY PICCIOTO SINGLES MADE IT 7-3 AND VICTOR CLOSED OUT THE SCORING WITH A 3 RUN HOMERUN TO MAKE THE FINAL SCORE 10-3. BUT PEACHE'S -N- CREAM BEHIND VICTOR AGAIN AND JACKY AND COMPANY CLOSED OUT THE GAME WITH A LATE RALLY TO WIN 17-10. SLAM DESPERATELY NEEDS A DOUBLE WIN NEXT WEEK TO HAVE A CHANCE AT THE PLAYOFFS.

AFTER 10 GAMES WE GET A GOOD VIEW OF THE TEAMS AND HOW DANGEROUS THEY ARE GOING TO BE IN THE PLAYOFFS. ALL SLIGHTS ASIDE BEDROCKERS ARE REALLY A GOOD TEAM. BUT THEY ARE NOT ANY BETTER THAN A FEW OTHERS WITH LESSER RECORDS. THE BEDROCKERS BUILT THEIR RECORD IN

EARLY SEASON GOING AND NOW MOST OTHER TEAMS ARE BEGINNING TO JELL
ESPECIALLY BIG TIME AND PEACHES -N- CREAM. PLUS THOSE TWO TEAMS
ARE VERY TOUGH IN THE PLAYOFFS. THEN THEIR IS HEAT WITH A PROVEN
PLAYOFF PITCHER IN RED NESSER. AND OUT OF NOWHERE COMES THE CHAMPS
OF LAST YEAR HAT TRICK LOOKING VERY DANGEROUS INDEED. THE PALS
ARE THE ONLY TEAM WITH TWO PITCHERS AND HAVE A LOT OF YOUNG PLAYERS.
AFTER THEIR DOUBLE LOSS TO HAT TRICK THEY ARE GOING TO HAVE TO PROVE
THEMSELVES IN THE COMING WEEKS BEFORE WE PASS JUDGEMENT. THEY ARE
NOW THE TEAM THAT GRAND SLAM AND THE RASCALS WILL SHOOT FOR TO GET
INTO THE PLAYOFFS SINCE THEY ARE IN THE LAST SLOT RIGHT NOW.
