    - Tryouts are complete across all levels, with the exception of Junior Gold which will start on November 18th

      - Goalie shortage created a situation where the U10B2 team has a single part-time goalie
    - U19
      - OMGHA does not have enough interest to field a U19 team, we are working across D3 and understand that Wayzata will host a team and may need additional players. We've been in contact with OMGHA families that have expressed previous interest to determine if they would be open to this potential opportunity.
  - Girls goalies
    - We've had preliminary conversations about the shortage of girls goalies at OMGHA. Most associations struggle with goalie #'s in girls hockey, so this is not unique to OGMHA, but over the past 3 seasons we've had 1, 2 and 1 full-time goalie enter U10 from the House program, respectively. With skater numbers entering the Travel program of approximately 30 each year, this obviously creates an issue with traveling teams having a enough goalies to cover the teams. At a minimum, we'd like to strive for 10% of our players playing goalie.

    - Travel Update by Deanna Henry
    - 526 travel players rostered on 29 travel teams with USA Hockey so far.
      Waiting for Jr. Gold to start.
    - 194 travel coaches rostered with USA Hockey with the exception of 28 who still need to complete their requirements
    - Maintaining an ongoing list of coaches who have actually been assigned as coaches and their requirements
    - Adding coaches to rosters daily once I see their trainings are being completed
    - 52 travel managers trained on their job duties,
    - Continuing daily communications as they set up their teams.
    - Tracking their background checks and SafeSport training
    - Waivers created, and submitted to D3 for all travel players that needed them.
    - Collecting Jersey Deposit Forms and checks for all travel teams.
    - Junior Gold players with 2002 or older DOB need to complete SafeSport in order to be rostered on an OMGHA team this year. At last count there are 11 of them that need to do so. Suggest reaching out to those players and get is completed prior to the start of the season.
    - Board Roster with USA Hockey– everyone needs to do the following by 12/15/2019
      - Register with USA Hockey \*
      - Submit a background check\*
      - Complete SafeSport\*
      - Send Deanna your USA Hockey number for tracking so you can be added to the roster
      - \*if you have already done these things because you are a coach, you do not need to do it again, just sent Deanna your USA Hockey number.
