

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE POLICY

The Kleinburg Nobleton Soccer Club, a not for profit, community focused youth sports organization, recognizes the need to assist families who may be experiencing financial barriers preventing their children in participating in sports.

The following options are available to all families to assist with the cost of player registration fees:

Canadian Tire Jumpstart Program:

Each year, Canadian Tire offers families who may need financial assistance the opportunity for their children to play sport through the Jumpstart program.

KNSC Sponsor Program:

Our Community Sponsors are a large part of funding for our club programs and initiatives. Their support allows the KNSC to keep registration fees fair, reasonable and consistent throughout the various seasons. A portion of sponsorship funds are directed to support families facing financial barriers.

Should a child secure a sponsor, 25% of the sponsor contribution will be directed to the player registration fees as a form of payment.

KNSC Financial Assistance Program:

The KNSC offers various levels of support for all families, especially those facing financial barriers. All processes outlined below will observe a high level of confidentiality.

KNSC Installment Plan (Development-Competitive Division): This option is available to all participants upon registration. The initial deposit is followed by 2 monthly payments.

KNSC Installment Plan (Recreational Division): Upon request, payments can be divided into 2 or 3 monthly installments.

KNSC Financial Assistance Application: Upon request, the application will be submitted to the General Manager for verification and approval. All applications will remain confidential, and notification of funding will be communicated to the appropriate parties.
