#### REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Teams or Individuals need to be pre-registered through your Membership Account at <u>USAWrestling.org</u> by 10:00pm Wednesday, May 1st. <u>Online payment is due at the time of registration</u>. If you have questions about this procedure, please call Stacey Medeiros at 907-223-5841 or Bob Ottum at 907-227-9153.

There are four (4) separate tournaments so please be sure to choose the correct one(s). Entry Fee is \$35.00 for each registered tournament. Onsite Registration Entry fee is \$60.00 per tournament for wrestlers not registered at USAWrestling.org before 10:00pm Wednesday, May 1, 2024.

#### Step 1:

Go to <a href="https://www.usawmembership.com/login">https://www.usawmembership.com/login</a> and sign into your account. Hover over "USAW Events" at the top of the screen. Click on "Event Registration" Change the "State" to Alaska, then click "Search Events" Click on the "Register" button for the Alaska USA Wrestling 2024 State Tournament Choose the profile of the wrestler being registered and proceed with the prompts Video bands can also be purchased here through Tickets

#### Step 2:

VERY IMPORTANT: <u>Wrestler must bring USAW Athlete card to weigh in.</u> Please <u>print wrestling card on paper</u> as most phones do not work well with the barcode scanner. A pairing/mat official will use a barcode reader to scan the card to bring the registration up in the system's weigh-in kiosk.

NOTE: Only FREESTYLE & WOMEN'S FREESTYLE are available to 6U and 8U age divisions.

16U may double enter in Junior

2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> year Juniors may double enter in Open

ALL girls may double enter in boys of their same age group

Participants wrestling only Freestyle (10U-Open) or Women's Freestyle on Saturday (10U – Open) MUST WEIGH IN FRIDAY NIGHT

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Once competitor's registrations have been received, <u>there will be no</u> refunds issued for any of the styles club members or individual members have registered for (unless there are extenuating circumstances).

**ELIGIBILITY:** All athletes must be a current member of USA Wrestling and meet age requirements. USA Wrestling cardholders who purchased their cards outside of Alaska USA Wrestling will be required to pay an additional \$10 AUSAW fee.

<u>INDIVIDUAL AWARDS:</u> Attractive medals to the top six placers in each weight class for Folkstyle Tournament, Freestyle Tournament, Greco-Roman Tournament and Women's Freestyle Tournament. Medals will be awarded each day after the tournaments are completed.

TEAM AWARDS: The top 3 teams for Folkstyle, Greco-Roman & Women's Freestyle will receive plaques.

There will be 2 divisions of teams based on size for Freestyle.

Division I - Teams with 30 or more wrestlers registered for State Freestyle Championship Tournament

Division II - Teams with fewer than 30 wrestlers registered for the State Freestyle Championship Tournament

Plaques will be awarded in each division to the top three (highest points) teams in the Kids Division (6U – 14U) and the top three teams in the 16U - Open Division.

A Grand Champion (Freestyle) trophy will be awarded to the team with the highest points – 6U through Open Age Divisions in each Team division.

<u>Triple Crown Belt Buckle</u>: Will be awarded to the wrestler who places 1st in 3 state tournaments. Criteria: must be 3 or more wrestlers in each weight bracket and there must be at least 2 teams represented in each bracket.

<u>RULES:</u> The rules of the UWW, with current USA Wrestling modifications where applicable, will govern the event. Headgear is highly recommended but not mandatory for all ages. Wrestlers with braces are recommended to wear a mouthpiece. Folkstyle will use current National High School Coaches Association Rules with USA Wrestling modification and 15 minute resting period.

<u>WEIGH-INS:</u> Each athlete must weigh-in at the official weigh-ins wearing a competition singlet & submit to skin & nail checks at that time, see medical info.

#### Reminder: wrestlers must bring a paper copy of their USAW athlete card to weigh in

1 parent/guardian may enter with 6U/8U wrestler. Otherwise, only wrestlers permitted in weigh in area.

### Thursday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> WEIGH IN:

<u>FOLKSTYLE Participants</u> must weigh in Thursday morning. Wrestlers wrestling in all three (3) styles may weigh in at this time.

All 6U & 8U Freestyle, 6U & 8U Women's Freestyle and Greco-Roman (10U – Open) participants MUST weigh in Thursday night.

NOTE: <u>Greco</u> can also weigh in at this time for Freestyle on Saturday.

#### Friday, May 3rd WEIGH IN:

10U - Open Freestyle & 10U - Open Women's Freestyle Divisions wrestling on Saturday ONLY - NO THURSDAY Weigh In.

If an out of town competitor is arriving later than the official weigh in, please contact the tournament director, Bob Ottum, at <a href="mailto:alaskausaw@gmail.com">alaskausaw@gmail.com</a> or call 907-227-9153. Bob Ottum is the <a href="mailto:ONLY">ONLY</a> person who can approve weigh ins outside of the posted times.

Competitors will be locked into the weight class they declare at the time of weigh in. If a wrestler chooses to bump up a weight class, officials must be told during the competitor's weigh in.

If Pairing Officials find there is only one person in a weight class, the wrestler will have the option of medaling with an exhibition match in that weight class or he/she will be allowed to bump up to the next weight class or Age Division which has more wrestlers, if applicable.

<u>PAIRINGS</u>: Separation of wrestlers from the same club when possible. USAW PIN Separation Criteria will be applied using line brackets placing to 6<sup>th</sup>. Bracket type is based on the number of participants as follows: 1-4 = Round Robin, 5-8 = 8-man, 9-16 = 16-man, 17-32 = 32-man

<u>COACHING:</u> Two (2) coaches maximum in each competitor's corner on the mat during a match. Coaches **MUST hold a** current Wrestling Leader card, USAW Copper or higher certification and a concussion training certificate to be in a corner. Coaches with these credentials will be issued coaches Wristbands to access the floor. Please attend the daily coaches' meetings to receive your wristband.

MAT ACCESS: Access to the wrestling area is limited to wrestlers, carded certified coaches, one person per corner with a video pass, and one parent escort per 6U and 8U. Wristbands will be handed out to carded coaches at the coaches' meetings and \$15.00 video wristbands will be available for purchase (through Tickets in registration and on site). The Video bands and Coaches' bands are good for all three (3) days of the tournament. Do not lose or remove them. Once a wrestler has wrestled, he/she will need to leave the wrestling area until the next match is assigned to a mat. All wrestling fans need to be in the stands and not in the wrestling area; a security team will be assigned to keep the wrestling area clear for the safety of our participants. Video bands are for active videoing of an upcoming wrestler. Just like the wrestler, you are expected to leave the floor after the match. Video bands are NOT a floor pass, please respect this, no loitering on the floor.

<u>MEDICAL INFORMATION:</u> Athletes must be prepared to submit to a skin disease screening prior to weigh in. The Head Official has full authority, with consult of onsite medical personnel, without appeal in determining the eligibility of an athlete to compete. In the event of injury or illness, no contestant will be permitted to continue the competition without approval of the Head Official and Tournament Director, with consult of onsite medical personnel, whose decision is final and not subject to appeal.

Each age division will be assigned specific mats during the tournament.

TOURNAMENT T-SHIRTS/ CONCESSIONS/ HOSPITALITY ROOM: State tournament t-shirts will be available for sale by Northwest Designs all 3 days. A Concession stand and outside food trucks will be available all 3 days. There will be a hospitality room for OFFICIALS AND CLUB COACHES ONLY (coaches who coach for a club and not just his/her own wrestler). Admittance will only be allowed to those wearing Officials' shirts and coaches with wristbands.
