

2020 BOYS PLAYER SELECTION/DEVELOPMENT CAMP

Open to players with birth years of 2003, 2004, 2005 & 2006

"Goalie Only" session March 19, 2020 for ALL Goalies of Each birth year March 20-22, 2020 for players (including Goalies) with 2005 & 2006 birth years March 21 & 22, 2020 for players (including Goalies) with 2004 & 2003 birth years

ALL Camp Sessions (except "Goalie Only" session-see below) for Each birth year will be held at the Ice Den - Chandler

Online registration thru the AAHA website is required for all participants

The Arizona Camp will be open to the first 30 Forwards; 18 Defensemen and 9 Goalies per birth year to register online. All players must be USA Hockey registered.

> Only US Citizens and residents of the State of Arizona are eligible to be selected for advancement to Rocky Mountain District Player Selection/Development Camps.

This Camp is for players who have demonstrated the necessary skill level and skating ability to warrant consideration of advancement to the next level of USA Hockey's National Player Development Camp process and is not for House Players or those with less than two years of experience.

Three separate ice sessions per age group

All registered goalies also receive a "Goalies Only" session on March 19th at Oceanside Ice Arena in addition to the three Camp ice sessions. If more than 6 goalies per any birth year/age division register for the Camp, the "Goalies Only" session will be used to reduce the number to 6 goalies per birth year/age division for the Camp sessions with skaters.

Partial refunds of \$120 will be given to any goalie that does not advance to the sessions with skaters.

Each birth year/age group will feature a Head Coach/Evaluator who will be assisted by a minimum of three coaches per birth year/age group. The Head Coaches/Evaluators will be responsible for the on-ice sessions as well as overseeing and having the final word in the selection of players chosen to advance to the next level.

The cost to attend the 2020 Camp is:

\$145.00 per player (including Goalies) thru March 2nd; \$160.00 March 3rd – March 9th

Registration for the Camp closes March 9th, 2020 or sooner if slots are filled

The Next Level of Player Selection/Development Camps

Boys with birth years of 2003, 2004 and 2005; and are US Citizens and residents of the State of Arizona will be eligible to advance to the Rocky Mountain District Player Selection /Development Camp in Dallas, Texas, May 8th thru May 10th. Additional information about the District Camp, including Frequently Asked Questions, will be available shortly on the AAHA website.

For those born in 2006, the Rocky Mountain District, the Pacific District and the Northern Plains District have joined forces to stage the "Western Regional Multi-District High Performance Select 14 Camp" which is similar in structure to a National Camp. This Joint Camp will be held June 14th thru the 19th in Colorado Springs, Colorado. 2006 birth year players selected from the Arizona Boys Player Selection/Development Camp will advance directly to this camp rather than to Dallas, Texas. 2003, 2004 and 2005 Players selected to attend the Rocky Mountain District Development Camp will be responsible for paying an additional fee of \$295 to the Rocky Mountain District for the camp and will be notified of registration and payment procedures by the District. 2006 Players selected to attend the Western Regional Multi-District High Performance Camp will be responsible for paying an additional fee of \$725 for the Camp which will include the player's room and board.
