Dibs Volunteers for Games/Scrimmages

Games/Scrimmages will require two (2) volunteers

- Volunteers #1 and #2 will arrive at the front door of the community center 20 minutes before the scheduled game/scrimmage time. The home team head coach/ team coordinator will open the two (2) lobby doors for you.
- IF you are the first game/scrimmage of the day (there were no practices or games before hand):
 - Volunteer #1 or #2 will need to go into the rink with the head coach/team coordinator right away and get into the coaches room to grab the lanyard with the key card and key. *The home team head coach/team coordinator can use their key card to open the "old" player's entrance doors and open the coach's room for you.*
 - The volunteer will then use the key that is on the lanyard to open the arena spectator doors (main doors to the arena). Once complete this volunteer will report back to the front lobby area with the other volunteer.
- Volunteer #1 or #2 will open the two (2) lobby doors for the players, head coaches, referees and home team score box workers 15 minutes before the start of the game. The second lobby door can be propped open if teams or coaches are in need of help to find the locker room assignments from volunteer #2.
 - IF one of the volunteers needs to leave to assist teams or coaches to find the locker room assignments, report back to the lobby to assist the other volunteer.
- Home Team coordinators will supply volunteers with rosters for both teams (home and away)
 - Volunteers will read off the player numbers on the printed roster and ask how many are with the player. *Teams will know we ONLY are allowing 2 spectators per player per our expectations and Minnesota Hockey. The home team coordinators will relay this information to the teams prior to their scheduled game/scrimmage.*
 - You do not need to ask for the spectator names
 - Siblings of the player, age 15 years old and younger, are welcome but must sit by their parent/guardian at all times. Siblings 15 years of age and younger will not count towards the two (2) spectators per player.
 - Home team parents working the score box and coaches on the player bench during the game will not count towards the two (2) spectators per player.
- Volunteer #1 or #2 will open the door to allow all spectators in 5 minutes before the scheduled game/scrimmage starts.
 - IF one of the volunteers needs to leave to assist the parents on their journey to the rink, report back to the lobby to assist the other volunteer.

- Return lanyard with key card and key to the coach's room. Hang on coordinator mail boxes.
- You are both officially done and may leave the arena.
