



WHK Refund Policy

2026/2027 Season

The WHK Hockey season for Mites thru Bantams officially runs for 7 months (September thru March). The season for Midgets runs for 3 months (August thru October). Our program is required to pay for many costs, specifically our ice rental at Bridgewater Ice Arena and our team costs to either the South Shore Conference or Bay State Hockey. We need to have a strict refund policy in order to be able to meet these demands. If your family believes they should get a refund, below is our refund policy:

Registration Payment: If your child does not attend any tryout, nor does your child pay the Roster Placement/Commitment payment, WHK will refund you this amount. **If a child steps foot on the ice during a tryout, attends any summer ice sessions, and/or is placed on a team without attending the tryout, the Registration Fee becomes 100% non-refundable.

Roster Placement/Commitment Payment: This is non-refundable. WHK has to create teams and make payments to the conferences to ensure our teams' placements. This Roster Placement/Commitment payment represents your commitment to WHK and our commitment to you.

Tuition Payments: There are several ways players might not continue with WHK. Below are some situations and our policy:

Player no longer wants to play for WHK - There are no refunds given if your child leaves WHK to play for another program.

Player no longer wants to play hockey - If your child decides he/she does not want to play hockey, WHK will refund any payment made, with the exception of the Registration payment and Roster Placement/Commitment payment. Please note, if your child plays in a game, attends any team practice and/or attends the skill sessions, no refunds will be given.

Injury (Mites thru Bantams) – If your child has a season-ending injury *prior to December 15th*, WHK will prorate the number of months missed (based on a 7-month season) and refund that amount. Please note, we will not refund the Registration payment, nor will we refund the Team Placement/Commitment payment. For example, if your child gets injured in October and cannot play the last 5 months of the season, the refund will be as follows (assuming a \$1,900 tuition):

\$1,900 Tuition less the Registration payment (\$200) and less the Team Placement/Commitment payment (\$200) equals \$1,500. The \$1,500 is divided by the 7-month season, which is \$215 per month. The refund would be \$1,075 (\$215 for 5 months).

Any injury *on or after* December 15th will not receive a refund.

Injury (Midgets ONLY) – If your child has a season-ending injury *prior to September 15th*, WHK will prorate the number of months missed (based on a 3-month season) and refund that amount. Please note, we will

not refund the Registration payment, nor will we refund the Team Placement/Commitment payment. For example, if your child gets injured in the beginning of September and cannot play the last 2 months of the season, the refund will be as follows (assuming a \$800 tuition):

\$800 Tuition less the Registration payment (\$200) and less the Team Placement/Commitment payment (\$200) equals \$400. The \$400 is divided by the 3-month season, which is about \$134 per month. The refund would be \$268 (\$134 for 2 months).

Any injury *on or after* September 15th will not receive a refund.

- *If you think your family should get a refund and it does not follow the above policy, the WHK Board has the right to review/discuss any request on a case-by-case basis. Please contact the WHK Treasurer and/or President and explain the situation.*
