Game Format and Covid Procedures

Revised 10-8-2020

This procedure has been updated to reflect the governor's new inside occupancy requirements.

Due to the ongoing Covid-19 Pandemic, the following procedures will be in effect at the Kenosha Ice Arena.

Ice Slot duration will be 1:00-1:30 in length and ten minutes between ice slots.

Ice will be resurfaced at the conclusion of each game or at discretion of the rink manager.

Building access will be limited in the following manner:

- Players, coaches and team manager will be allowed into the building twenty five minutes prior to scheduled ice time.
- Off ice officials should enter the building five minutes prior to ice time and report directly to the score box.
- Spectators should enter the building at the beginning of their team warm up and should report directly to the grandstand. Team managers should confirm that the grandstand is clear of previous game spectators and alert their team it is safe to enter. Spectators should vacate the grandstand and building immediately upon the conclusion of their game to allow the next team time to enter.
- Grandstand access will be limited to two spectators per player. This is in conjunction with Wisconsin COVID guidelines limiting indoor gatherings. Social distance and proper mask use should be observed at all times in the building.

Face coverings are required by all occupants of the building at all times. The only exception is with on ice participants who do not require face coverings while heading to and from the ice, or on the ice.

Lobby restrooms are available, however absolutely no loitering in the lobby.

Locker room access will be as follows:

- Home team will use locker rooms 1-4 with each team assigned to two locker rooms.
- Visiting teams will use temporary locker rooms 6 and 7.
- The coach's locker room will be available for anyone with an assigned locker.

Home team should use the player's entrance, Visitor team should use the front doors

Players and coaches should proceed directly to the locker room upon entry to the building and remain there until the preceding teams have returned to their locker rooms upon conclusion of their game.

Teams should vacate the ice immediately following the final buzzer and return to their locker room. Players should remain in their locker rooms until the following game has begun and the lobby and exit areas are clear.

The teams preparing to take the ice should remain in their locker rooms until the preceding team has left the ice and returned to their locker rooms. The goal is to keep teams from encountering each other without masks.

Teams should be out of the building 20 minutes after their final game buzzer for locker room cleaning.

No congregating in the parking lot after games. Again, our goal is to keep groups at a minimum.

The Board of Directors reserves the right to make changes to this procedure as required at any time. This procedure is intended to be in place until 12-31-2020, at which time it will be re-evaluated to coincide with local health department regulations.
