**\*Note that the candidate must meet all three minimum scores for the level they wish to pass, in addition to having each element receive a score of > 0 total points. (A disqualifying “0 value” element will be noted on the protocol with the symbol “ - - - ” in lieu of a GOE or points awarded.) There must not be more than 2 falls in a singles free skate. (rule 1071) Skaters must request test credit to the local organizing committee prior to the start of their event. This is usually done at on-site registration or online. (TN 281) ISUCalcFS results report copy must contain signatures of Technical Controller and Referee Requirements include ISUCalcFS results copy signed by Technical Controller and Referee, detail report and Companion form.**

**\*\*Only protocols from masters-intermediate-novice free skate events may be submitted for adult intermediate and adult novice free skate test credit.**
