### East County Softball Protected Player Status Rules

1. The manager of each team can select up to four (4) players before the first day of the player assessments to be part of their team.
2. Each of these players is considered a protected player for this season only.
3. One of these players must be the manager’s daughter (if applicable).
4. If one sister in the division is protected, the other sister must be protected as well.
5. Protected players have the option of attending tryouts (not required).
6. For a player to be protected on a team, the player’s parents must agree in writing on this form provided by the league.
7. A player must be registered no later than the day this list is due to be eligible to be protected.
8. If a player decides to withdraw from protected player status on or after the first day of tryouts, their eligibility to be a protected player on any team is withdrawn. If league tryouts have not been completed then the player will participate in tryouts and go into the draft. If tryouts have been completed, the player will be selected as part of the “fish bowl”.
