

2024-2025 Coaching Season Update

The Atlantic District Coaching Education Program (CEP) will begin hosting virtual clinics in July, presented through Zoom tele-conferences.

- Clinics for CEP Levels 1-2-3-4 will continue through early December
 - In order to register for a coaching clinic, ***you must be first registered as a coach for the 2024-2025 season***
 - Clinics are posted at www.usahockey.com/coachingclinics
 - Clinics in the Atlantic District will be scheduled on Monday-Tuesday evenings, and occasionally Wednesday-Thursday evenings
 - Times will be 6:30 pm to 9:30 pm for both nights, and sessions will be similar to those in previous years
 - Atlantic District coaches are requested to register for CEP Clinics offered by the Atlantic District, but have the option to register for a clinic in any District that fits within their time constraints.
 - If you are registering for a clinic in another District, make sure that it is virtual as transfers from one clinic to another may not always be possible
- Each CEP level is valid for one season only
 - CEP Level 3 certification no longer offers a recertification
 - CEP Level 4 and Level 5 will now carry an expiration date three years out
 - Coaches are now required to complete continuing education
 - Over the course of the three years, a coach must complete five [5] hours of continuing education
 - Continuing education programs will include online training, specialty clinics and workshops [e.g. body contact and checking,] and full day high-performance oriented sessions
 - **There are no waivers for continuing education and Temporary Certification requests are not available**
