

Professional Membership Reminder

- If you took your Safe Sport Course (U110) prior to August 1st
 you will need to re-take it prior to 12/31 to remain active and compliant.
- This is because the US Center for Safe Sport does not have their certification calendar aligned with every NGB's membership "season" dates.
- Anything that comes out from Safe Sport is driven by Safe Sport. USA Gymnastics needs to remain compliant with their requirements.



2026 State Championship Dates

- March 21-22 Level 8, 9, 10 States at Shrewsbury High School
- March 28-29 Level 5, 6, 7 States at Fitchburg High School
- April 25-26 Level 4, Platinum, Diamond, Sapphire States at Shriners Auditorium
- May 2-3 Silver and Gold States at Shriners Auditorium
- May 9-10 Level 1, 2, 3 and Bronze States at Shriners Auditorium

How to Qualify to States

All competitions HIGHLIGHTED IN YELLOW on the MA Qualifying Calendar can be used as qualifiers to States.

- Levels 1-5, Xcel must qualify from an IN-STATE qualifier.
- Levels 6-10 may also use OUT OF STATE qualifiers, with scores and Sanction # for verification.
- Any athlete who is repeating a level can enter directly into the current season's State Championships if the following criteria is met:
 - 1. They competed at that level's previous year's States AND
 - 2. They achieved the state qualifying score at the previous year's States.

State Qualification Criteria

Xcel (All Divisions)

Must compete in one IN STATE competition from the USAG-MA Qualifying Calendar.

• Levels 1-2-3

Must compete in one IN STATE competition from the USAG-MA Qualifying Calendar.

• Levels 4-5

32.0+ AA at one IN STATE competition from the USAG-MA Qualifying Calendar.

• Levels 6-7-8-9-10

32.0+ AA at one IN STATE competition from the USAG-MA Qualifying Calendar OR

32.0+ AA at one OUT OF STATE competition.

Declaration Date

- February 2, 2026 for all Dev. Program Levels and Xcel Divisions.
- The highest level that an athlete competes in 1-4 events in a sanctioned competition after the "declaration" date designates her level for the remainder of the current season. See next slide for DD clarification from USA Gymnastics...

DECLARATION DATE

Friendly reminder

An athlete may NOT drop back to a lower level/division in a competitive season <u>AFTER</u> the declaration date.

SAC determines prior to the beginning of the competitive year, a designated "declaration" date for each level for this purpose.

The highest level/division competed at a sanctioned competition after the "declaration" date will determine the program (Dev / Xcel) for which the athlete can compete for the remainder of that season. It does NOT matter if an athlete competed in 1 event or as an All-Arounder, if they competed a higher level/division after the declaration date they are bound by the qualification rules of that level/division for the rest of the season. DO NOT MAKE THIS MISTAKE!!!

State Calendar Construction

- First wave Outside Venue Invitational Requests submitted and added to the calendar.
- Second wave All In-gym Invitational and Qualifier Requests submitted and added to the calendar.
- Things to remember:
- ➤ Host Organizations can only have ONE (1) qualifying meet designated on the calendar. They can host other competitions which will be listed on the calendar, but they cannot be designated as qualifiers.
- ➤ Host Organizations, Meet Directors and Competition Venues MUST be located in MA to be listed on the calendar.

State Calendar

- The most up to date version of the MA Qualifying Calendar is posted on the MA website.
- USAG MA has hired Kathy Ostberg as our Independent Assignor to handle the assigning and contracting of officials through our Arbiter portal.
- For competitions that are already listed on the MA Qualifying Calendar, if you have secured your own officials, you should have already submitted your list of officials to kathyostberg@gmail.com.

How to Register for MA State Championships

Submit your Meet Reservation online at www.usagym.org, then process payment online at www.meetmaker.com. Refunds will only be distributed to scratches that are submitted online in Meet Reservations AND processed via MeetMaker by the entry deadline.

STATE ENTRY FORMS

- <u>As soon as</u> all of your athletes have qualified to their respective State Championships, please submit the <u>REQUIRED</u> qualification form to <u>massusagcommittee@aol.com</u>. One form per competition. Please do not wait until the deadline to do this!
- Forms that are submitted later than the Qualification Deadline, not completed in their entirety, or not completed correctly, will be assessed a \$5.00 per athlete verification fee (\$500 maximum).
- Forms that are submitted on or prior to the Qualification Deadline, completely and correctly, are at no charge.
- Forms will be available on the website by October 1st. Remember You do not have to wait until the QD gets close to submit your forms!

STATES AWARDS

- All Around placements will be awarded with medals at State Championships beginning with the 2025-2026 season.
- All ties for individual event and All-Around placements will be awarded with the same color medal that corresponds with their placement.

Please plan ahead -Beginning with the 2026-2027 season, MA State Championships will not include a Level 1 competition.

REGIONAL APPAREL

For clubs that have Regional qualifiers at Levels 6,7,8 and all Xcel Divisions, MA-USAG will provide each club with 2 coaches shirts PER DAY based on the competition schedule.

RESULTS POSTING FOR MEET HOSTS

Beginning with the 2025-2026 season, all sanctioned competitions held in MA will be required to post their results to BOTH myUSAGgym and Score Cat within 24 hours of the conclusion of the competition.

Hosting a Meet – Xcel Judging Requirements

Per Rules & Policies:

Beginning with the 2025-2026 season, a two (2) judge panel is <u>REQUIRED</u> at the Platinum, Diamond and Sapphire Divisions for all mobility and qualifying meets.

A one (1) judge panel may be used for mobility and qualification at Bronze, Silver and Gold.

Hosting a Meet – Dev. Judging Requirements

A two (2) judge panel is **REQUIRED** at levels 5-10 for all mobility and qualifying meets.

A two (2) judge panel is **REQUIRED** at Level 4 for all qualifying meets in MA.

A one (1) judge panel may be used only for mobility at Levels 4 and 5.

A one (1) judge panel may be used for Levels 1-3.

After Hosting a Meet...

After hosting **ANY** USA Gymnastics Sanctioned competition:

- Close sanction with USA Gymnastics.
- > Pay the additional Sanction Closing fees with USA Gymnastics.
- Beginning November 1st send \$2.00 per gymnast (maximum \$1,500.00) to Region 6 via MeetMaker. Detailed instructions will be provided by MeetMaker prior to November 1st. Any sanctions between now and November 1st can wait until then to pay the head tax with no penalty.
- If the \$2.00 per athlete head tax is not paid to Region 6 in the 30 days following the conclusion of the competition, the amount per athlete raises to \$3.00.
- PTF sent to <u>massusagcommittee@aol.com</u> (must be done by the Wednesday following the competition).
- Publish results to myUSAGym <u>AND Score Cat</u> within 24 hours following the competition.

Mobility Meet Reminders

- If you have hosted a Mobility Meet, please submit those PTFs to the massusagcommittee@aol.com email address as soon as possible and publish the results to myUSAGym AND SCORE CAT.
- If you attended an out of state mobility meet, please send a copy of those scores with the sanction number to the massusagcommittee@aol.com email address.
- As per R&P, virtual meets are not allowed for mobility purposes.

Individual Event Specialist (IES)

- Mobility through levels 7-9 is an 8.5.
- Gymnast needs to score an 8.7+ twice in any qualifying meet to qualify for states.
- To qualify to Level 9/10 Regionals, an IES needs to score a 9.0+ at states on their respective events.
- There is no opportunity for Level 7, 8 or Xcel IES athletes to qualify to Regionals.
- ❖ If at States an athlete does not attain the qualifying AA score to Regionals, but scored a 9.0+ on certain events, that athlete may still enter Regionals on the events in which she attained the 9.0+.
- LES who are entering States but did not qualify with an AA score, must designate their events upon States entry and are not eligible to compete in any events in which they did not qualify.
