



# FORWARD MADISON SOCCER CLINICS

## STADIUM GUIDELINES

The stadium will be sectioned off into four quadrants. Each quadrant will operate as its own entity and have separate parking, entrance, exit, check-in, arrival guidelines, restroom guidelines, sanitation stations and social distancing guidelines. Each quarter of the turf field will be approximately 175' by 107.5'. These dimensions allow for a 10' buffer separate each quarter of the turf field. Below you will find guidelines on each function, along with a stadium layout graphic to reference.

## PARKING

Each quadrant will have designated parking areas around the stadium. Below you will find the four parking areas that correlate with the four quadrants, along with a parking map.

- Quadrant 1: E Washington Street (Closest to capital) and S Paterson Street
- Quadrant 2: N Paterson Street and E Mifflin Street (Closest to the capital)
- Quadrant 3: E Mifflin Street (Furthest from Capital) and N Brearly Street
- Quadrant 4: S Brearly Street and E Washington Street (Farthest from capital)





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## ARRIVAL

We require all clinic participant to arrive to the stadium no earlier than 10 minutes prior to their session. There will be a 15-minute buffer between session one concluding and session two starting. This allotted time will ensure for safe exit and entry.

## ENTRY/EXIT

Each quadrant will have a designated entrance and exit. Patrons are required to enter and exit out of the assigned quadrant gate. See assignment list below.

- Gate 1: Quadrant 1
- Gate 4: Quadrant 2
- Back Gate: Quadrant 3
- Suite Entrance: Quadrant 4

## CHECK IN

Each quadrant will have their own check-in area. This area will be inside of the designated gate. The area between the gate and the check-in booth will have footprints on the ground to ensure patrons adhere to public health's most recent social distancing guidelines. The check-in area will be touchless to limit touchpoints and contact with Forward Madison staff. This individual will confirm the arrival and escort the participant to their designated 10' by 10' square within the quadrant.

## EQUIPMENT

Each participant will be asked to bring their own soccer ball and water bottle. Forward Madison will NOT supply soccer balls or water for clinic participants. Each player will be asked to place their belongs in an empty 10' by 10' square adjacent from the square they occupy. Forward Madison FC players and coaches will help facilitate during check-in.

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## SOCIAL DISTANCING SQUARES

Each quarter of the turf field will be segmented into 10' by 10' squares. On page 4 you will find a stadium layout with an example of these squares. An X illustrates a square occupied by a clinic participant. All 10' by 10' squares surrounding each clinic participant will be empty. This will limit cross over and promote a safe training environment in each quadrant. The coaching staff and FMFC players will not enter any of the squares occupied by the clinic participants; instead, they will utilize the empty squares surrounding each participant to facilitate instruction and demonstration.

## RESTROOM USE

Each quadrant will have an allotted time prior to the clinic starting for participants to use the restroom. If a participant needs to use the restroom during the clinic, a coach or staff member will make sure the restrooms are unoccupied before escorting the participant to the restroom.

## PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

Each participant is allowed one parent or guardian to accompany them to the clinic. The parent or guardian will be required to watch from the designated sections in each quadrant. Each section will be set up to adhere to public health's most recent social distancing guidelines. Social distancing guidelines will be clearly visible upon entrance to each area. See section list below.

- Quadrant 1: Beer Garden
- Quadrant 2: Section 102
- Quadrant 3: Section 113
- Quadrant 4: Flock End

## CAPACITY

Each quadrant will have no more than 15 participants and no more than two coaches or players. To limit exposure between groups, coaches and players will be assigned to a single quadrant for the entire night and will not be allowed to leave their designated area. Viewing areas in each quadrant will not be allowed to exceed 15 individuals, 1 parent or guardian per participant. The maximum capacity of each quadrant will be 50 persons.







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## SANITATION GUIDELINES

Below is an outline of comprehensive sanitation plans for the stadium and staff

### VENUE SANITATION/CLEANLINESS

- A sanitation station will be available for each quadrant. The station will be located at check-in. Participants will be required to use the sanitation station before entering the quadrant.
- Breese Stevens Field staff will sanitize touchpoints, and all surfaces every 30-minutes. This cleaning schedule will guarantee all touchpoints and surfaces will be sanitized before, during and after each session.
- Bathroom doors will be propped, and garbage lids will be open to reduce touchpoints

### HYGIENE

Forward Madison FC staff, players and coaches are required to follow the hygiene guidelines listed:

- Temperature check prior to entering the stadium
- Always wear a mask
- Wash hands before and after each session
- No physical contact with other Forward Madison colleagues, clinic participant and all other patrons in-stadium
