

2025 Love 2 Lax Tournament Guidelines

Teams Will Play 2- 20 minute halves 2 minute halftime 3 minutes in between games Championship will be one 18 minute half

High School, Middle School, Youth (2033, 2032) DIVISIONS (12v12)

*All US Lacrosse Rules apply at this event

- Teams must be ready to take the field at the conclusion of the previous game. Please be ready to play as you enter the field.
- Time outs: There are no timeouts. The deputy is not allowed.
- All substitutions must be made at the 50-yard line through the substitution area.
- 8 Meters: will be played out at the end of a half/end of the game.
- Draws will be taken to begin each half and after every goal.
- Yellow and red cards will be used according to NFHS rules. Red card means the player sits a game in the tournament.
- Slaughter rule: if a team is up by 7 goals the losing team has the option to take the ball, rather than the draw (Middle School/Youth only)

3rd/4th Grade Division will play 8v8: (7 field players and a goalie)

*All US Lacrosse Rules apply at this event

- No Checking for 7v7 Division
- Teams must be ready to take the field at the conclusion of the previous game. Please be ready to play as you enter the field.
- 1 pass over the center line
- 50 yard line is used as restraining line. 2 players back at all times
- Time outs: There are no timeouts. The deputy is not allowed.
- All substitutions must be made at the 50-yard line through substitution area.
- 8 Meters: will be played out at the end of a half/end of the game.
- Draws will be taken to begin each half and after every goal.
- Yellow and red cards will be used according to NFHS rules. Red card means the player sits a game
- Slaughter rule: if a team is up by 7 goals the losing team has the option to take the ball, rather than the draw

Scoring:

Scores will be kept at the 50-yard line of all fields. Coaches should check scores frequently and will sign off at the end of the game. Scheduled games can end in a tie. If score is tied at the end of the Championship game, there will be a full field braveheart 1 field player, 1 goalie from each team

Teams will receive:

2 points for a win

1 point for a tie

0 points for a loss

Tie Breakers:

- 1) Head to Head (first 3 games on schedule)
- 2) Goals Against
- 3) Goals For
- 4) Flip a coin

Checking:

- Full Checking HS, 2030, 2031
- Modified Checking 2032/2033
- No Checking 3rd/4th Grade Division 2034/35/36

Goalie Equipment:

- Goalies must wear shin guards (for Youth/MS), padded pants, chest protector, helmet, mouth and throat guard, and goalie gloves.
- Helmets & chest protectors must be NOCSAE Certified.
- Please make all attempts to have a goalie in the cage. If unable to find a goalie, we will have a shot blocker as a last resort.
