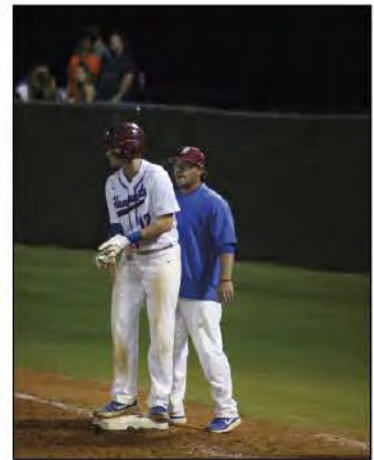


Jacob White- Freshman Head Coach
