Adam S. Hamilton Tournament Rules

National Federation of State High School Associations rules will apply to all games.

Each team participating in the tournament will compete in three round-robin games, then a fourth game on Sunday, December 2 at 9:50 a.m. or 12:00 p.m.

During round-robin play, each team will earn 2 points for a win, 1 for a tie, and 0 points for a loss. The two teams with the highest point totals will participate in the Championship Game.

In case of a tie in total points earned during round-robin play, the following tie breaker system will be instituted to determine who plays in the Championship Game.

Head to head competition Goal differential Least goals against Least penalty minutes

Which team scored the fastest goal in regulation during round-robin play.

The team who earns the most points during round-robin play will be the home team during the Championship Game. The team who earns the third most points during round-robin play will be the home team during the Consolation Game. (If tied, the above tie-breaking system will be instituted to determine the home team.)

If the score is tied after three periods during round-robin play, the two teams will play a 5 vs. 5 eight minute sudden death overtime to determine a winner. If no goal is scored the game will end in a tie, and both teams will earn 1 point.

If the score is tied after three periods during the Championship Game, the two teams will a play 5 vs. 5 eight minute sudden death overtime to determine a winner. If tied after eight minutes, an ice cut will be made, then the NHL style of 3 vs. 3 overtime play will commence, until a winner is determined. During the Consolation game, the overtime format for the round-robin games will be in effect.

An ice cut will be made between each 15 minute period.

Each game will include a ten minute warm up.

A maximum of twenty players may be dressed and included on the official score sheet.

Pucks will be supplied by the tournament hosts.
