## √ Tentative Tournament Schedule for 2022: See attachment

- o We provide the jerseys which the girls get to keep at the end of the season
- o It is SO important to make it to all of these tournaments if you can't please let your coach now asap!!

#### √ Fees:

- \$400 for the season this covers, tournament fees, coaches pay, gym fees and jersey's!!
- o Also, each team will have two practices a week and 7-8 tournaments

## √ Tournament Info:

- Must be gym ready by 7:30
- o Pool play is in the morning. Tournament play in the afternoon
- o Bring snacks, folding chairs and plenty of water for your player
- O Your player can't leave the gym as they ref between games
- U10's and U12's and U14B's play Saturday (most of the time) and U14 A's and U16's play almost always Sunday
- This year there are no A and B brackets, it will be Open and Club and every team will be seeded depending on their record.

## √ Commitment:

- This is HUGE, we need ALL the girls to show up to ALL tournaments and practices!! This is competitive club volleyball, if you don't fully commit it's not fair to your coach, team and club!!
- This is club volleyball, your child's play time in tournaments will be dependent on their skill, position, participation in practice and attitude!
- No cellphones during practice, they are there to practice.
- Practices will be closed parents can not stay to watch unless it is an open scrimmage or something the coach has arranged ahead of time. This is to ensure your player is focused on their team. There will always be a board member present at all practices.
- RESPECT is key, respect your teammates, coaches and other teams. Bullying and disrespect will absolutely NOT be tolerated.

## √ Team Placement: will be the week of February 6th @ Dean Morgan:

o Monday and Tuesday U10 7:00-8:30/ U12 7:00-8:30

- o Wednesday and Thursday U14/U16 7:00-9:00
- √ We have room for a couple more U10's and one or two more boys!!

## PLAYERS

Acceptable standards of player behavior include:

- 1. Treat opponents with respect; shake hands prior to/after contests.
- 2. Respect the judgment of officials and abide by the rules of the contest.
- 3. Accept seriously the responsibility of representing your family, team and the Club by displaying positive behavior at all times.
- 4. Play in a positive manner, reflecting core ethical values. Physical and verbal abuse will not be tolerated! Racial slurs of any kind will not be tolerated!

## PENALTIES

Any player ejected from a game because of unsportsmanlike conduct will be suspended from the next game and may be subject to additional penalties by the appropriate sport commission.

## PARENTS AND SPECTATORS

Acceptable standards of spectator behavior include:

- 1. Remember that the players are young people and receive benefits from the mental messages that can be applied to life.
- 2. Remain seated in the spectator area during the games.
- 3. Respect decisions made by contest officials.
- 4. Be a role model by positively supporting teams and by not shouting instructions or criticism to the players, coaches, or officials. Do not coach from the stands!
- 5. Make no derogatory comments or gestures to players, coaches, spectators of the opposing team, officials, or league administrators.

Remember that coaches and parents set the example for the behavior of their team's fans. If you see fans of your team behaving in a negative manner, please try to appeal to their conscience at an appropriate time.

## PENALTIES

Any spectator who displays poor sportsmanship may be removed from the facility by an official, their team coach, a league official, or the host gym supervisor. Any spectator who interferes with the conduct of an activity, at the discretion of the spectator's school, league, can be barred from attendance at subsequent athletic activities.

Any disrespect to the players and coaches will be handled with a warning and if there is a 2<sup>nd</sup> offense it will be brought to the board members to decide how to handle each situation.

## ENFORCEMENT

#### The Board members, shall

enforce this code. Complaints regarding violations of this code shall be first brought to the attention of the appropriate Administrators. Coaches, participants spectators may be placed on probation or suspended from activities for their actions.
