BYHA HOC Coaching Coordinator

The BYHA HOC Coaching Coordinator is responsible for the following:

- Working with Coaches to make sure they have the coaching requirements completed before the season starts. This includes their coaching applications, getting coaches registered with BYHA, USA Hockey CEP Certification, Safesport Certification, Age Specific Modules, Back Ground check and code of ethics.
- The coaching coordinator is responsible for finding applicants who wish to be a head coach, setting up interview times (in early August) and working with the VP of HOC, a board member and the A/B Coordinator from HOC to choose the appropriate coaches for the top levels. All other coaches will be selected after tryouts are completed.
- The coaching coordinator will setup a pre-season meeting (usually the week after tryouts - at Wild Marsh) to get coaches together to talk about the upcoming season. The CC will also select guest speakers to come present to the coaches. In the past it has been Miek MacMillian, Aaron Johnson, Thomas Johnson, Zack Sickitch and many others.
- The CC is also responsible for working with the safesport coordinator to make sure the players have a safe and positive environment. Should problems arise, the CC is there to represent or possibly reprimand the coach.
- The CC is responsible for providing resources to the coaches throughout the season to help and create development. This can be done with reoccurring meetings or via email support.
