- 17u only: July 20th, Berne Union High School, 5PM
- 19u and 17u: July 26th, Beavers Field, 6PM
- 19u and 17u: July 27th, Beavers Field, 1PM
- 19u and 17u: August 17th, Beavers Field, 6PM

Eligibility for our 2020 teams:

- 17u: Anyone born on or after Jan. 1, 2003
- 19u: Anyone born on or after Jan. 1, 2001

Please arrive 30 minutes early for registration and try to make at least two tryouts.
