

# GEVA Officiating Team Requirements Overview

Each team must meet the following education and certification requirements.

See other documents at [www.GEVA.org](http://www.GEVA.org) for more specifics about how to register for online clinics and more detailed requirements.

## Coaching Education:

Each Coach must complete GE19\_109 (Junior Coach Officiating Team Training – Table), which teaches the fundamentals of Scoring.

It is strongly recommended that they also complete GE19\_110 (Junior Coach Officiating Team Training – Floor). This will be required next year and teaches the fundamentals of Second Referee and Lines Judge.

## Player Education and Certification:

Each team must certify a player Scorer and Second Referee (R-2).

Certification consists of 2 parts.

**Junior Scorers** must complete GE19\_103 (New and Renewing Junior Scorer), which includes a quiz. This clinic must be completed regardless of whether the player has attended an in-person clinic. Then the score sheets from actual tournaments are submitted to the Junior Officiating Education Coordinator by tournament Site Directors for review. Approval by the Coordinator completes the certification.

**Junior Second Referee (R-2's)** must complete GE19\_104 (New and Renewing Junior Second Referee), which includes a quiz. This clinic must be completed regardless of whether the player has attended an in-person clinic. The First Referee will evaluate the candidate's performance as R-2 during a tournament match, with a pass or no-pass in the Remarks section of the scoresheet. The Junior Officiating Education Coordinator then completes the certification from information on the score sheet.

## Recommendations:

- One player should officiate as R-2 until certified before a team attempts to certify a second R-2.
- Multiple players can score the same match to certify more than 1 scorer at a time. Secondary score sheets must be submitted directly to the Coordinator: [PegVB@aol.com](mailto:PegVB@aol.com)

## Other Education

So others may have a role in team officiating assignments, it is suggested other team members complete:

- GE19\_101 Junior Lines Judge.
- GE19\_102 Libero Tracker.
